


Jason and Rachel Bulman will lead the meditation and reflection. Jason is in formation for the permanent diaconate and is a practicing physician

Reflections from the Heart by Fr. Ivan

"Whoever is not against us is for us." The Cross remains for us the one definitive act of God's love where he expresses unconditionally his love for all humanity. The Cross symbolizes God allowing himself in Jesus to be cursed and utterly humiliated for the sake of saving us. God proves his love to the point of death



on a Cross. Jesus would tell us no one has greater love than this. How does the Cross make you feel? What do you see when you look upon the Cross? Do you see Jesus dying because he chose not to disclose that you are the one, not he who is guilty of blasphemy? Jesus embraces the Cross for the love of poor sinners. When given the Cross, he embraces it, kisses it and graciously carries the Cross to repair and atone for our sins and pay the price for our sinfulness. He never complains. He remains silent not telling anyone how guilty we are. What if you were asked to help carry the Cross? How would you respond? Would you try to find an excuse or walk away? Would you look at Jesus with contempt as Simon did? He was concerned for himself wanting everyone to know that unlike Jesus, he was innocent of any crime, he was not a criminal. Simon has to be forced to assist Jesus. Do you have to be forced to assist Jesus? As Simon helps carry the Cross, he encounters the God who loves him. One look into Jesus' eyes and Simon sees humility, innocence, vulnerability, love, patience, peace. Simon cries for he realizes the truth about who Jesus is. He is not a criminal. He is innocent. He is the Messiah who has allowed himself to be bruised, beaten and broken for the salvation of souls. Simon understands he is a poor sinner in need of redemption. He is a poor sinner in need of this cross. He understands that he is not helping to carry Jesus' cross but that Jesus is helping him to carry his cross. What do you see when you gaze upon the Cross? Can you see God pouring out all his love until it hurts? Can you see God giving everything until it hurts no more? Do you understand that no one loves you more than this or can ever love you more than this? As Jesus carries the Cross, that is, as Jesus carries your cross, he is loving you in every step, in every fall, to the point of death - death on a cross.

St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist – September 21st

In the Gospel of Matthew, the name appears in the list of apostles, and is identified as his call as "a man named Matthew, sitting at his custom post." (Mt. 9:9). Later in the list he is called "Matthew the tax collector" (10:3). In the other

synoptic gospels tradition identifies him with Levi (Cf. Mark 2:13: Luke 5:27).

Tradition credits him as the author of the gospel that bears his name, (though some believe that the text we now have is the work of a Jewish Christian from Antioch from around the year 90). We know nothing of his later life. Tradition says he preached in Judea and later in Ethiopia where he was martyred.

The Gospel of Matthew has a unique point of view, namely to show Jesus as the Messiah foretold in the Old Testament. In his introduction to this gospel in The Jerome Biblical Commentary, John L. McKenzie wrote: "There are points of contact between Matthew and rabbinical writings that are not found in the other Gospels. These points of contact are more than an interest in the Law and allusions to Jewish institutions. Matthew sometimes moves in the world of rabbinical thought. He not only is familiar with rabbinical teaching; he uses it."

Matthew wants to make the point for a Jewish audience that "Jesus Messiah is the new Moses and the new Israel, and the fulfillment of the Law and the Prophets". There are 41 references to the Old Testament in Matthew's gospel, and Fr. McKenzie points out that 37 of them are introduced with a formula, most commonly "that it might be fulfilled."

Jesus is shown as a teacher who is superior to the rabbis. A long summary of the teaching of Jesus is given as the Sermon on the Mount, which is kind of a "catechism of Christian conduct." The miracles show Jesus as the messianic wonderworker. The kingdom of heaven (or of God) is presented as a present and future reality and is identified with eternal life. Matthew's originality is in his explicit identification of the present kingdom with the Church: "I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock, I will build my church." (16:18). Further on in the gospel, Jesus instructs in the matter of fraternal correction. "If he refuses to listen to them (three witnesses), tell the church. If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector." (18:17). Many of the parables, too, teach of the church as an existing society.

"On hearing Christ's voice, we open the door to receive him, as it were, when we freely assent to his promptings and when we give ourselves over to doing what must be done. He ever refreshes us, and he Himself is delighted by such a pleasing banquet." Today we ask St. Matthew to help us remain faithful.


