#### Reflections from the Heart by Fr. Ivan

"Lord, your love is eternal; do not forsake the work of your hands." When we consider the word "eternal," other words come to mind like everlasting, undying, unending, perpetual, endless, ceaseless, timeless, always, forever, without beginning and without end. We therefore can only speak



of God in these terms for only God is everlasting, undying, unending, perpetual, endless, ceaseless, timeless, always, forever, without beginning and without end, eternal. In referring to God in these terms and in this way, we can better understand who God is and how he forms an everlasting bond and eternal friendship with the masterpieces he creates and the gracious works he forms with the use of his hands. In these terms, we can better describe and speak of God's attributes, which are timeless, and more accurately describe the eternal relationship he shares with all creation and how he relates personally and intimately to his beloved creatures in and through creation. Saying God is eternal is by nature the same as saying God is love, therefore, God's love is and must be eternal. Love is eternal and will last forever and always. God's love is forever always, and will perpetually be the same always. His love endures forever, therefore, God's love is without end. Scripture reminds us that without love, without God, we have nothing, gain nothing, and are nothing. However, with love, with God, we can bear all things, believe all things, hope all things, and endure all things for God who is love never ever fails. God is most patient forever, his kindness is undving and his mercy eternal. At times, we choose to use eternal words to describe our own friendships life and the situations in experience. However, can we truly say and mean with absolute certainty and truth when we say to another person, I will never hurt or fail you? Will you never fail and never hurt another individual ever, promise? Never in thought, never in words, never in speech, never in intention, never ever, ever fail or hurt another individual? Can someone else really say and mean that they will never betray you, that they will love you always, or that they will be your best friend forever? Can we make those kind of statements without adding or including God to the statement who truly is eternal? Shouldn't we clarify forever statements by adding "with the help of God's grace" or "only in Christ"? Then we can say with confidence and truly mean our love is eternal, our friendship forever, by including God's grace.





#### St. Stephen of Hungary - August 16



The first king of Hungary, crowned on Christmas Day in the year 1000 with a crown sent by Pope Sylvester II, St. Stephen (969-1038) is a national hero as well. To him goes the credit for establishing his country as an independent kingdom and integrating it into

Europe. This was a work begun by his father who with his ten year old son was baptized about 985.

Once he had secured peace for his country as its king at the turn of the century, he introduced Christian principles into government. He took great interest in the spread of the Church, founding centers of missionary and spiritual life. He was aided in this by his wife Gisele, sister of St. Henry, who became the Holy Roman Emperor about the same time in 1002. His own son was Blessed Emeric who was to succeed him, but who was killed in a hunting accident in his early twenties. He also shared his father's ideals and interest in the spread of Christianity in Hungary.

To Emeric, Stephen wrote, and in these admonitions we get a glimpse of Stephen's faith and his concern for the poor and needy:

"My dearest son, if you wish to honor the royal crown, I urge you above all to maintain the Catholic and apostolic faith with such diligence and care that you may be an example for all those placed under you by God."

Stephen goes on to explain that the Church needs "prudent and trustworthy guardians" lest she should be destroyed through "idleness, indolence, and neglect." He continued to offer counsel to guide his behavior to the poor and to all:

"Show favor not only to relations and kin, or to the most eminent, but also to foreigners and to all who come to you. Be merciful to all who are suffering violence. Be patient with everyone. Be strong. Be humble. Be truly moderate. Be gentle so that you may never oppose justice. Be honorable so that you may never voluntarily bring disgrace upon anyone. Be chaste. All these virtues make up the royal crown and without them no one is fit to rule here on earth or to attain to the heavenly kingdom." (Second Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

Reading exhortations such as this, of Stephen to his son, gives us an appreciation of what committed faith can accomplish in one who sincerely strives to live in the spirit of the gospels. The concern of the Church for us is evidence in offering us the saints as models to be admired and imitate, and as intercessors to be our powerful helpers in Heaven.


### FLORIDIANS SHOULD DECLINE TO SIGN PETITION FOR DANGEROUS PRO-ABORTION AMENDMENT

An extremely grave initiative is underway in Florida that seeks to erase pro-life protections by inserting language into the Florida Constitution banning regulation of abortion. Abortion activists are working to gather petition signatures to place a pro-abortion constitutional amendment on the November 2024 ballot. This amendment would allow abortion up until birth, including when the baby is capable of feeling pain, and would eliminate laws requiring parental consent and safety protocols for women.
