### Reflections from the Heart by Fr. Ivan

"Let me now sing of my friend." As years pass, we seem to continue to lose sight of the true meaning and concept of friendship as a trustworthy, reliable individual who is much more than a confidant but also someone committed to stand by



us in the greatest celebrations and under the worst circumstances and situations. Friendship is rapidly losing its meaning and perhaps has already lost its truest intent. We allow our friends to be those who favor our online content and like our postings. The notion of friendship is reduced to a membership we hold, value dearly and maintain only through technological settings or social platforms. However, we remain thankful that what was true in the Old Testament about friendship is true in our New Testament experiences. Scripture invites us to consider it is not enough to say my close, dear, or even best friend. The bible uses the word faithful to help describe the true nature of friendship. "Faithful friends are a sturdy shelter; whoever finds one finds a treasure. Faithful friends are beyond price, no amount can balance their worth. Faithful friends are life-saving medicine; those who fear God will find them." Meaning, a faithful friend is built on a solid relationship that is able to withstand even the most terrible and frightening situations. A faithful friend cannot be purchased or bought or paid for but rather is more valuable than the world's most priceless gem and considered a true treasure. True friends are life giving and life saving. Praise God. Jesus shows us the depth and the heart of true friendship and the model for being and having faithful friends. He says, "no one has greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends." Jesus calls us friends because he wills only what is good and right for us under the loving gaze and assistance of God and what would be truly helpful in maintaining a true and honest friendship and relationship with him. Jesus goes on to say, "I have called you friends, because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father." This is the heart of friendship. To know and come to believe and understand the depth of God's love for us, the mercy he has bestowed upon us in his beloved Son, and the eternal breath of life he has poured into our hearts and lungs through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Beloved, we are God's children now. He has befriended us for life. This is the song we sing.







### The Guardian Angels - Memorial, October 2



"Bless the Lord all you angels of the Lord, sing his glory and praise forever." The text of the Collect and the Prayer after Communion tell what this feast is about. "God our Father in your loving providence you send your holy

angels to watch over us" (Collect). "By the ministry of your angels, lead us into the way of salvation and peace" (Prayer after Communion). This is a day of praise and thanks to God for his providence and goodness.

In Christian and Jewish belief, angels are spirits created by God before human beings to regulate the order of the world and serve as messengers. Their mission to human beings always has something to do with God's plan of salvation. In the Old Testament, the message is often barely distinct from God, and appears in order to guide individuals or the entire chosen people. The personification always maintains the sovereignty of God, yet it is always understood that God is intervening in human affairs. The same is true of the angels' visits in the New Testament, in the dream of St. Joseph, the Annunciation to Mary, the angels who assist Christ after the temptations in the desert, and the angels at the tomb.

Their division into classes was a medieval development, and really does not add anything to our appreciation of angels. Through them we understand the presence, knowledge and will of God for us, in the circumstances of our lives (Cf. "Angels," by Richard Woods, OP, in The New Dictionary of Theology, Glazier, Inc. 1987).

The liturgy for this feast honors the angels as persons, pure spirits, messengers of God and it has been a traditional teaching that these spirits are our helpers. "Under their constant care," we are kept "free from danger in this life" and brought to "the joy of eternal life." (Cf. Prayer over the Gifts). In the sermon that is part of today's Office of Readings, St. Bernard tells us:

"So, let us be devoted and grateful to such great protectors, let us return their love and honor them as much as we can and should. Yet all our love and honor must go to God, for it is from Him that they receive all that makes them worthy of our love and respect."

Whatever may be the nature of the spirits that surround God and carry out His designs, it is through their submission to Christ, the great mediator, that they serve the divine plan of creation and salvation.
