#### Reflections from the Heart by Fr. Ivan

"Thus says the Lord GOD: I myself will look after and tend my sheep." The image of God as Shepherd is probably the most intimate image in bible text that describes the profound relationship God has with his people, his



creation, and all of his children. It is certainly more than just a title or a name. It describes the unchangeable reality of an on-going relationship that existed before time, continues through out today and remains endless, eternal, and timeless forever and ever. It cares for and carries a most distinctive and humbling image of a person who lives for the absolute good of the other assuming all the responsibility for guiding the other, all of us, to a place of comfort, light, happiness and peace. The image describes the tender source of all that stands being sacred. The relationship provides warmness in the cover of a loving embrace, security under watchful protection, nourishment, friendship, spousal covenant and all that brings goodness, beauty and trust. The Good Shepherd lays it all down lovingly, selflessly, without hesitation or reserving anything for himself. All given freely, truthfully, simply because the Shepherd loves his sheep that much. The image of God as Shepherd goes to the depth of covenant fidelity and to the heart of faithfulness to commitment. God is committed to this relationship. When God promises, he makes good on all he promises. He does not break a promise, for promises are sacred and faithfully kept. They are carefully and faithfully upheld and fulfilled. In the relationship of Shepherd and sheep, God is present and always available to his flock in good times and in the worst of times. He stands by us in the best of health and in the most serious of circumstances and situations. God's love is undying and remains active in death and forever in the life eternal. The Shepherd consistently provides for all we need, remaining committed to us. He sustains and strengthens us in our journey Encouraging us with the faith that moves life. mountains. The Shepherd knows our voice and the sound of our cry and the flow of our tears. He responds to the cry of his children with a mother's love and a father's gentle care. God never turns away. He never turns us away but rather is drawn to us if only we would cry out and shout out his name not only in danger and in need but also trustingly in joy and in thanksgiving. Call on the Good Shepherd who so gladly and happily calls us by name.





#### St. Josaphat, Bishop and Martyr - November 12




St. Josaphat was a martyr for Christian unity. Successful for a time in the difficult ministry to Lithuanian and Ruthenian Orthodox Christians, his death in 1623 ended hopes for reunion with the Catholic Faith.

Born of Orthodox parents, Josaphat (1580-1623) embraced the Catholic faith and became a Basilian monk at Vilna, Lithuania. He was a compelling preacher and an advocate of union of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church with Rome. Appointed Bishop of Vitebsk, Russia and later Metropolitan Bishop of Polotsk, he initiated reforms. Those who opposed him brought charges that he was interested in Latinizing the Ukrainian Orthodox Church. It was these quarrels that led to his martyrdom in 1623. He was canonized in 1867, the first formally canonized saint of the Eastern Catholic Rite.

Pope Pius XI in his encyclical letter Ecclesiam Dei (1923), said that St. Josaphat:

"Is rightly looked upon as the great glory and strength of the Eastern Rite Slavs. Few have brought them greater honor or contributed more to their spiritual welfare than Josaphat, their pastor and apostle, especially when he gave his life as a martyr for the unity of the Church. He felt, in fact, that God had inspired him to restore worldwide unity to the Church and he realized that his greater chance of success lay in preserving the Slavonic rite and St. Basil's rule for monastic life within the one universal Church."

We honor him for his courage "to lay down his life for his people," and ask that we would also be "strong and willing to offer our lives for our brothers and sisters." (Collect of Mass).

In many Polish homes throughout the world, a beloved family tradition is the breaking of the oplatek on Christmas Eve. Oplatek is a thin wafer made from flour and water

similar in taste and consistency to the hosts that are used for communion during Mass. Oplatki are often stamped with an elaborate Christmas scene.

Historically, these would be distributed by the church to parishioners' homes during the Advent season. The Christmas wafer is shared before Wigilia, the Christmas Eve supper. Wigilia comes from the Latin word "vigilare" which means to wait.

The oplatek is meant to remind families of the Eucharistic bread at Mass and makes a further connection between Christmas and the gift of the Eucharist, the presence of God among us.



"Simbang Gabi, the Filipino word for "night mass" is a nine -day devotional series of Masses attended by Catholics in the Philippines at early dawn leading to Christmas Eve. This year our church joins other parishes in celebrating Simbang Gabi in several churches in the diocese. 
