Created in God's image and made in the holiness of God, we belong to this perfect family graciously given to all humanity by our heavenly Father as a gift and model to aspire to become. Eucharistic Adoration on New Year's Eve



Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God



Mary was celebrated from an early time in the life of the Church as the "Mother of Jesus," but with the Council of Ephesus in 431 she was declared the "Mother of God." Beautiful mosaic

depictions of her as Mother of God are to be found in churches in Italy and Greece. After the Second Vatican Council, it was decided to celebrate this feast of her divine motherhood during the octave of Christmas, linking this feast to the celebration of Christ's birth. The purpose of today's liturgy is to honor the role of Mary in the mystery of our salvation, and at the same time to sing the praises of her unique dignity as the one through whom we have been given "the gift of the Author of life."

The picture of Mary presented to us in St. Luke's gospel account is of a reflective, meditative woman. Just like Abraham, she has given her "Yes" to God's will but the implications of that "Yes" have still to become clear to her. Nevertheless, Mary trusts God and is counted among those who, as Luke says, "hear the Word of God and keep it."

That picture of Mary, striving to understand God's grand design for her, should cause us to reflect, to meditate, and to think deeply about the Word that we hear at mass and about our own part in God's plan. In some way, as our founding pastor, quoting St. Ignatius, indicated over the years, we must, as did Mary – "listen closely to the Word, reflect upon it, respond to it, and relish it." If we are seeking a New Year's resolution, this would be a good one – to be people of the Word who reflect and respond.

Surely in our troubled times, both at home and abroad, part of God's plan for us is that we should be instruments of God's peace, making fruitful use of that freedom of God's children bestowed on us in Christ – of which St. Paul wrote to the Galatians. As we seek God's peace and offer it to others, we can be confident of Mary's spiritual motherhood for each of us; and should turn to her with confidence to intercede for our needs.

On this day, as we honor the Mother of God, we recall St. Bernard's description of Mary as "our tainted nature's solitary boast." I pray that The Lord will bless and keep you, lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace that will fill your hearts and minds.


