

#### Reflections from the Heart by Fr. Ivan

Moses spoke to all the people, saying: "A prophet like me will the LORD, your God, raise up for you from among your own kin; to him you shall listen." God is a good listener. He is the best listener ever. There is no one better at listening than God. God is the greatest listener of them



all. When you speak to God, our Lord listens with great intention on listening to you. He is not distracted rather he remains attentive to your every word. Receiving all that you say without interrupting you or speaking like thunder over you or responding to you without letting you finish what you would like or have to say. God is patient that way. He will never put you on hold or multitask through your conversation whether you speak aloud or relate the conversation silently to yourself. God will not say, I am sorry, can you repeat that, I wasn't really listening to you. God's ears never grow tired from listening to your voice. Even if you think or say that God is tired of listening to you, he really isn't tired, he is God and loves you and all his children. Although your words at times can be harsh, self-seeking, judgmental, prideful and boastful, God never tires listening to you because he loves the sound of your voice even if at times your voice sounds critical, selfish, self-absorbed, elevated and misdirected. God still listens to you like no one else can, will or does. God listens to your heart. He listens to your heart through his heart, which is patient for you, present to you, available to you always, even when you are speaking or when you are sleeping. However, we tend to talk rather than relate. We speak rather than listen. We tell rather than ask. We mouth off rather than being still and silent and knowing that God is in our midst listening to our every word. The words we mouth off and even those words we mouth off in violent thoughts in the conversation in our head. God is still listening. He is listening to you right now. If God is such a great and gentle listener then why do you speak to him that way rather than pray the same way God listens? With patience, intention, gentleness and affection. If God is the only listener, then why don't you speak to him more often and share with openness and honesty what is on your heart. God is listening. Say something nice.

Who are you? If I met you at one of our gatherings, you would most likely introduce yourself by your name. You might elaborate with a connection regarding where you work or where you go to school or how I might know your family. Our connection, our communion is from generation to generation, from the very beginning, more wondrous than you might imagine. As each one is conceived, our name becomes eternal as a child of God!

In our naming, God bestows upon us His divine love. He gives His very heart to us through His Son, Jesus Christ. He joins with us as part of salvation history. Salvation is not something that happened, but is happening, is alive through our bringing Christ to everyone we meet.

The psalmist tells us that we are blessed as we seek God with all our heart. It is not a plural 'hearts', but one heart—the heart that is through, with and in God. 





#### St Agnes, Virgin, Martyr - January 21st



Of the early Roman virgin martyrs, we know little other than what legends tell us, or what we learn from some of the great Fathers of the Church who left us sermons commemorating celebrations in

honor of these heroic young women.

St. Agnes is said to have suffered martyrdom at the age of 12. "The cruelty that did not spare her youth shows all the more clearly the power of faith in finding one so young to bear it witness." (St. Ambrose, Treatise on Virginity, Book 1; Cf. 2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

The martyrdom of St. Agnes is factual, but the details are legendary. A beautiful young girl of a wealthy family, she resolved early to live purely and to consecrate her virginity to God. This was not an uncommon practice even in the third century. Denounced by unsuccessful suitors, she was sent to a house of prostitution. There she successfully preserved her virginity by her saintly conduct and in one instance by a miracle. She was ordered beheaded, or stabbed in the throat. St. Ambrose remarked that she was "too young to know of death, yet...ready to face it."

The Collect of Mass tells us that God chooses "what the world considers weak to put worldly power to shame." St. Ambrose continues: "In the midst of tears, she sheds no tears herself. The crowds marvel at her recklessness in throwing away her life untasted, as if she had already lived life to the full. All are amazed that one not yet of legal age can give her testimony to God, though her testimony in human affairs could not yet be accepted. What is beyond the power of nature, they argue, must come from its creator." (Op. cit.).

"While still so young, she overcame death and found true life." (Responsorial to 2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours)


