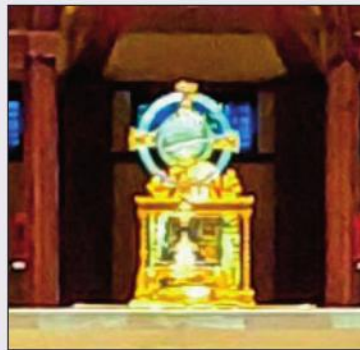

**Reflections from the Heart by Fr. Ivan**



"See, I am now establishing my covenant with you and your descendants after you." From the very first dawn of light and even so much time before it, God entered into covenant with creation. God entered into a holy matrimony with his creation even before he proposed to it. At the very thought of bringing creation forth, at the inception of bringing it into existence and being, God already promised to be faithful to creation in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health. God promised and vowed fidelity and faithfulness to his creation by loving it, maintaining it and honoring his vows all the days of our life and all the ages of the eternal life, that God lives for eternity. God in his infinite love and holy wisdom saw the goodness of creation. From the moment of its original and initial thought, into the moment of its conception and through its formation and its birth, God saw creation and all that he creates and would create to be very good. God could see creation through its life destined for union and communion with God and could see the death it would cause by turning away from God's covenant and would rather seek to be greater than greatness itself and become more powerful than power itself. A selfish thought; a foolish desire, a destructive idea. God could foresee the tragic effects of the fatal fall creation would cause and have to experience and still love loves, continues to love, will always love and would love once again. God would determine and decide the rising again, the restoring of life, the honoring of the friendship that would be necessary. God's love foresees and foreshadows healing, reconciliation and forgiveness that love would have to accomplish. Great love and divine mercy would have to conquer great sin and world suffering. So much work and effort to create. So much time and patience needed to redeem and save. So much, it would take to call out creation to love and come back to love again. The Lord would have to experience tremendous mocking from his rebellious children. The Lord would have to endure the rejection that will transpire from having to call out repeatedly to his creation to return to innocence and to honor the covenant that gave it life and fashioned it into being. Still our faithful covenant God, who is love personified, chooses to love and to remain in loving covenant even before he creates, knowing how unfaithful his creation would become. That's love.

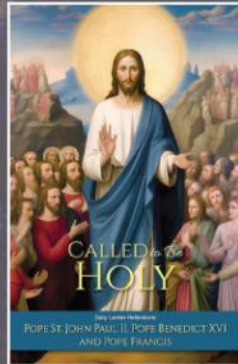

**Fasting & Abstinence** Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all 18 years of age and older who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Abstinence is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all other Fridays of Lent by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Remember: If your health or your ability to work would be seriously affected, fasting or abstinence does not apply.

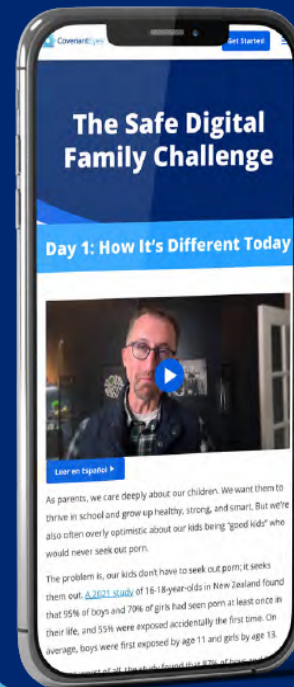

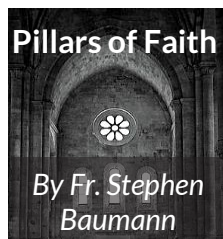

**St Cyril, Monk and St. Methodius, Bishop – February 14th** - Sts. Cyril and Methodius were brothers who are



honored as missionaries to the Slavic peoples. Their work of teaching and laboring among them during the mid and late ninth century is still evident today. They left a heritage in language and liturgy especially. The strength of the Slavic faith goes back to the missionary efforts of these holy brothers. Cyril was a monk and probably a priest, and Methodius was, for a time, governor of a Slav colony, and then became a monk, abbot, and later bishop.

Their missionary efforts met with frustrations, difficulties and unjust accusations of heresy. This was due largely to their use of the vernacular language in the liturgy. Their efforts and courageous acts have enriched the spiritual and liturgical lives of the people of a vast area of Eastern Europe: Bulgaria, Bohemia, Southern Poland, and Yugoslavia. The cultures of these places are indebted to them as well.

St. Cyril died in Rome in 869, while St. Methodius continued his work for another fourteen years. He died on April 6, 884. Recognition is given to their work and their vision by the Second Vatican Council in the Decree on the Catholic Eastern Churches, where it states: "History, tradition, and very many ecclesiastical institutions give clear evidence of the great debt owed to the Eastern Churches by the Church Universal. Therefore this holy council not merely praises and appreciates as is due, this ecclesiastical and spiritual heritage, but also insists on viewing it as a heritage of the whole Church of Christ." (Orientalium Ecclesiarum, n.5).

In another place the Council stated: "The Church, which has been sent by Christ to reveal and communicate the love of God to all men and to all peoples, is aware that for her a tremendous missionary work still remains to be done. There are two billion people - and their number is increasing day by day - who have never or barely, heard the Gospel message; they constitute large and distinct groups united by enduring cultural ties, ancient religious traditions, and strong social relations." (Ad Gentes, the Decree on the Church's Missionary Activity, n. 10).

In the lives and in the humble, dedicated service and missionary activity of Sts. Cyril and Methodius and their disciples we can all find inspiration, and through their prayers we can all "become one in faith and praise." (Collect)
