Reflections from the Heart by Fr. Ivan

“This is my beloved Son. Listen to him.” Perhaps the most essential tool we truly need to consider and make ready during our spiritual journey on the everlasting way is to learn how to listen to the Lord with attention, presence and with good intention. We tend to listen to noise, to lies and to others tell lies of other people. Rather than listening to truth, to scripture, to Jesus we choose to listen to curse words, foul language and blasphemes uttered by people we know, love and trust. Rather than listening to words that are uplifting, encouraging and quite insightful, we choose to listen to profanity and vulgarity then repeat what we hear like a bad joke or an embarrassing situation at another’s expense. Listening requires knowledge, knowledge understanding, and understanding discernment and good spiritual discernment leads to a well-informed decision to speak the good we hear from God and to avoid permitting any evil talk to pass by our ears or lips and even to resist evil words from entering our hearts or thoughts. How we speak speaks volumes about the company we keep and the people or person that has captured our spiritual attention and given a listening ear. Truly listening to God and desiring to hang on his every word is both virtuous and a gift. To want to hear what God has to say and to want to share with others what God shared with you is both a grace and a gift. Listening requires silent, contemplative prayer. We have to practice prayer and practice listening in order to hear and receive the intimate knowledge God personally speaks to you in response to your need, to your petition, to the grace you sought after. We must pray and ask God for the grace to learn how God speaks to us, and the particular words he chooses to reach us. We must invest some sacred time for intentional pray to understand what God is saying to us and the purpose for the words he chooses to reach us, heal us, teach us, instruct us, and inspire us. If you listen carefully to the tone of an individual, the phrases they use, the words that come from their mouth, the promises they make or those promises they break and the excuses they give, that will give a good indication to whom they are listening. If the words are kind, full of compassion, mutually forgiving, shed light on gospel truths, then chances are good that God is speaking and you are listening to him.

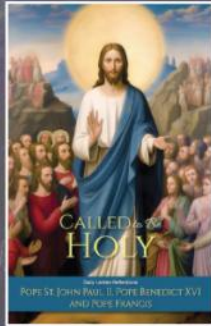

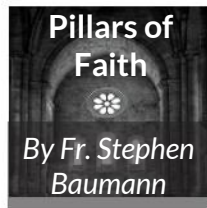

Talking Back: Scripture's to Answer Common Fears | Fearless | Episode 3

St Peter Damian, Bishop & Doctor – February 21st - Peter was orphaned when very young, and was mistreated by the brother who was his guardian. He was rescued however by another brother who was archpriest of Ravenna, and who saw to his education. Peter became an excellent teacher, and out of his own experience developed a sensitivity to the poor, sharing all of what he had with them. Even prior to his resolve to become a monk, he fasted, prayed for long hours and undertook other disciplines.

Eventually, he joined a community of hermits and became abbot about the year 1043. From that time on, he was called upon to be a peacemaker and settle disputes among religious and civil authorities. In 1057, he was appointed Cardinal-Bishop of Ostia, and reluctantly came out of his solitary life. He made Christ and the service of the Church his first love throughout his life.

Later, when he was permitted to resign his see (diocese) and return to his monastic life, he continued to write and to work for reform of the Church. His concerns were to rid the Church of simony (the buying and selling of indulgences) to correct the laxity of clergy.

From Peter Damian's writings, we come to some understanding of the asceticism (practices of self-denial) of his time. In the article, "The Gregorian Reform," by Karl F. Morrison, we read "Cardinal Peter Damian described how he combined mortification of the will and body as a practice while reciting penitential psalms and prayers. Such practices were designed to intensify devotion and fervor, particularly the sense of sharing in the poverty and sufferings of Christ." (Christian Spirituality: Origins to the Twelfth Century, p. 189).

From Peter Damian's own writings we have: "When men suffer pain for the evil they have perpetrated in life, they should take some reassurance. They also know that for their good deeds undying rewards await them in the life to come. The way that God deals with men can only be praised. He allows them to suffer in this life to shield them from suffering in the next. He pins them down before healing; He throws them down in order to raise them anew." (From his letter; Liturgy of the Hours; 2nd Reading).

That was the spirituality and asceticism of the time. We do not embrace today everything that motivated St. Peter Damian, such as harsh penances, but we understand him in the light of his time in the tenth and eleventh centuries. We cannot fault him for his vision, zeal, and self-discipline. Today, we prefer to preach about the virtue of love in the saints' lives.
