


Our Elect participate in the Scrutinies at the 8am Mass this weekend, the 10am Mass next weekend and then the 12noon Mass for the final Scrutiny before the Easter Vigil.

#### **Question: What are Scrutinies?**

Answer: The Scrutinies are important and special rites of the Church celebrated on the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent, by those people who are preparing to be baptized at Easter, known as "The Elect". The Scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth and the life. The Gospels, from the "A" cycle, on the three Sundays on which the Scrutinies are celebrated teach the elect about the mystery of sin, and fill them with the Spirit of Christ. ### Reflections from the Heart by Fr. Ivan

"I, the LORD, am your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that place of slavery." Forgetfulness, like things SO many we encounter and face throughout the day has some benefits but also through it, we encounter great losses and spiritual defeats. The tempter and



enemy of our human nature has mastered the use of forgetfulness and is quite cunning in the ways he causes us to forget God and to forget others. He draws us back into the state of sinfulness to the point we want and desire to reenter our own personal Egypt, that place of sinful slavery where we are enslaved and imprisoned by sin and do not recall or remember God has set us free. The enemy distracts us through forgetfulness. He floods us with thoughts of worry and concern. He encourages us to forget God's grace and the gift and power and the use of prayer. The enemy incites us to defend ourselves, go at it alone, rely on our own strength, rather than to remember God is greater than any problem we face. God is greater than all creation. God is greater than all he creates. God has already defeated the enemy, recall the Way of the Cross - the humility of God, his Passion, the suffering and death of his Son, the Resurrection; the waters of Baptism that set you free and gave you back your life. The victory is God's, the benefits and graces are yours. In the Garden of Eden, the enemy began to interrogate Adam and Eve, questioning their recollection of what God said and the things he flat out forbade. questioning is a tactical use of forgetfulness causing them and us to forget God's word, reinterpreting what God said for our own selfish use and selfish gain and drawing on our disordered intentions to be independent from God, equal to God, better than God. Oh, how we forget the One who created us in such beauty and goodness. Oh, how we forget the One who provides for our daily sustenance and cares for our joy and brokenness. Oh, how we forget the One who suffered and died that we may remember and live again. Jesus clearly says in scripture and in Mass, "do this in memory of me." He gives us the gift to remember no one has greater love than the One who calls us personally friend, died for our sinfulness, ransomed us and set us free. God's mercy forgives our sins. His love forgets them. Remember; never forget.











### **Lenten Outreach**

**Fasting & Abstinence** Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all 18 years of age and older who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Abstinence is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all other Fridays of Lent by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Remember: If your health or your ability to work would be seriously affected, fasting or abstinence does not apply.



**St Katherine Drexel** - As a wealthy young woman, at age 20, Katherine Drexel (1858-1955), decided to use her considerable inheritance for the benefit of the poor. Her stepmother, Emma Bouvier, was a definite influence on her life, both with respect to her piety and her love and concern for the poor. In her early 20's Katharine began to think of a religious vocation. After the death of her father, she and her sister began to use their wealth to help others.

At first counselled to continue her philanthropic work outside religious life, Katharine, at a private audience with Pope Leo XIII, in 1887, spoke of the need to have more priests work with the American

Indians. The pope's response to her was a surprise: "Why not, my child, yourself become a missionary?"

Upon returning home Katharine accompanied Bishop James O'Connor of Omaha on a tour of western missions. A year later she decided to become a religious sister and entered the novitiate program of the Sisters of Mercy. However, on February 12, 1891, Katharine made final vows as the first Sister of the Blessed Sacrament for Indian and Colored People.

Her life's work lay ahead of her and for the next forty years she directed the work of her Congregation of Sisters. By the year 1935 when Katharine suffered a heart attack, the Sisters had 49 foundations (missions) in the west and the south.

Throughout her life, Katharine was a deeply religious woman and a model of piety (prayerfulness). Her declining health and the subsequent necessity to turn over her administrative duties to others finally allowed her more time for the contemplation to which she was originally attracted in religious life.

In 1941 Pope Pius XII wrote to her and described her work as "a glorious page in the annals of the Church." Katharine died at the age of 96, on March 3, 1955. She once wrote: "The patient and humble endurance of the cross, whatever nature it might be, is the highest work we have to do." And only fifteen years before her death, she had written: "Oh, how far I am at eighty-four years of age, from being an image of Jesus in his sacred life on earth."

On November 20, 1988 she was beatified by Pope St. John Paul II who spoke of her life as one "of exceptional apostolic service." In his homily at the Mass of Beatification, the Holy Father said "she was a woman of lively faith, deeply committed to the truth revealed by Christ, the truth she knew so well because she constantly listened to Christ's voice."

Much of Katharine's spiritual strength was drawn from the Blessed Sacrament, as Pope St. John Paul II noted: "She was always eager to deepen her love for Jesus, whom she received and adored each day in the Eucharist. Her union with Christ the King gave her confidence that whatever was done in His name would bear much fruit for the sake of the Kingdom."

Her last twenty years of life were quiet and intense, as she prayed in a small room overlooking the sanctuary. Small notebooks and slips of paper record her various prayers, ceaseless aspirations, and meditations. She was canonized by Pope St. John Paul II in the year 2000.

It is our privilege to remember and honor one of our own, American St. Katharine Drexel, who lived so close to our place and time. She was a virtuous, holy woman whose zeal for the Faith was nourished by her contemplation of the Word.


