St. Dominic, Priest - August 8th



"Dominic possessed such great integrity and was so strongly motivated by divine love, that without a doubt he proved to be a bearer of honor and grace." This was written of our saint for today.

In the same collection of writings we read, "Wherever he went, he showed himself in word and deed to be a man of the Gospel...He seldom spoke unless it was of God, that is, in prayer, or about God; and in this manner he instructed his brothers." (Cf. 2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

Dominic (1170-1221), is popularly known as a great preacher and the founder of the Dominicans. His own efforts as preacher and those of his immediate followers were directed to combating the heresies of the Albigensians who denied the Incarnation of Jesus, repudiated the sacraments, and held other extremist ascetical (harsh penitential) views.

From childhood, Dominic showed signs of a vocation to the priesthood that was encouraged. He also gave evidence of a great concern for the poor. During a time of hunger, he sold his books and precious items to feed the poor. Like St. Francis of Assisi, he saw poverty in practice as a remedy for many of the ills that afflicted the Church in the late 12th and early 13th centuries.

Not only was Dominic a capable and inspiring preacher, but his life was exemplary. Holiness of life was a weapon against error as well as his preaching. Dominic's ideal was to combine prayer and asceticism (penitential practices) with study and the ministry of preaching. What one preached is learned in prayer and contemplation. "Bring to others what you contemplate," is the motto he gave to the Order he founded. His last years were spent organizing his followers into a community, the Order of Preachers.

The spirit and ideals of St. Dominic are alive today in the community he founded, both of men and women. Pope Gregory IX said of him: "I knew him as a steadfast follower of the apostolic way of life. There is no doubt that he is in heaven, sharing the glory of the apostles themselves."

In the Collect for the Mass on August 8th, we pray that his "holiness and teaching" will "come to the aid of" the Church, and that "he help us now with his prayers as he once inspired people by his preaching."

FLORIDA'S PRO-ABORTION AMENDMENT EXPLAINED

Why Floridians Should Vote NO on Amendment 4

Titled "Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion," Amendment 4 would enshrine UNREGULATED ABORTION in our state constitution, making Florida one of the MOST PRO-ABORTION states in the nation. The amendment language is **MISLEADING**, and its proposed outcomes are **DANGEROUS**.

WHAT IT SAYS

BALLOT SUMMARY

No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion

before viability

or when necessary to protect the patient's health,

as determined by the patient's healthcare provider.

This amendment does not change the Leaislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or quardian before a minor has an abortion.

WHAT IT DOES

PUTS WOMEN AT RISK

Amendment 4 would jeopardize existing laws and prohibit new ones that voters on both sides of the abortion issue support, including health and safety laws that protect women.

ALLOWS SECOND AND THIRD TRIMESTER ABORTIONS

Though not defined in the amendment, "viability" is defined in Florida law as the stage of development when the life of a fetus is sustainable outside the womb (Ch. 390.011(15)), generally accepted to be 22-24 weeks of pregnancy, or about 6 months.

CREATES A BROAD "HEALTH" LOOPHOLE

"Patient's health" is not defined in the amendment, allowing post-viability, extremely late-term abortions for treatable, temporary health concerns. Emotional health would justify an abortion when a child could survive outside the womb.

WEAKENS MEDICAL DOCTOR REQUIREMENT

"Healthcare providers" - not just physicians - could determine if an abortion is "necessary" to protect the mother's "health." Even some employees of abortion clinics, such as nurses and counselors, could approve late-term abortions.

ELIMINATES PARENTAL CONSENT

While preserving parental notification in our state constitution (Article X, Section 22), the amendment would invalidate the current law that requires parental consent for a minor to have an abortion (Ch. 390.01114(5)), making abortion the only medical decision for which parents have no say.
