

REFLECTIONS FROM THE HEART by Fr. Ivan

Jesus said to the Twelve, "Do you also want to leave?" At times, we also think and believe Jesus' sayings are hard and difficult to receive and difficult to understand but the reality is his words directed personally and lovingly right at you are meant to free and heal you and to speak directly to what is aching and broken inside of you. The truth will always set you free, therefore, what is unloved and unresolved inside of you, what is aching and hurting inside of you and what is unreconciled and unforgiven inside of you, always needs to hear the truth, only the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, for lies do not heal. They can only hurt us even more. Why is it so easy to listen to and believe a lie? Why is it so socially acceptable to take confidence in an untruth, tell a little lie, or encourage deceit and deception? Why does listening to a fallacy, believing in what is not accurate or proposing a falsehood seem like music to your ears? Why do we believe a lie never hurts anyone yet the truth is that saying a lie to your spouse, your friends or your loved ones always hurts everyone. Not telling the truth unfortunately is what our poor ears and hearts are accustomed to hearing, listening to and believing. Lies flood our hearts, our families and our ears drowning out truth to the point that we unfortunately do not really know, believe or understand what the truth sounds like. With wounded ears and a lack of forgiveness in our hearts, we say that the truth hurts when in reality the truth will always set you free. Lies distort our image of God. They cause us to question who God really is. God is the face of mercy, the heart of love, the grace that heals you, the compassion that receives you, a poor sinner, into his heart, his house, his family and his home. Lies make us believe that it is difficult to change, to let go, to trust, to believe that God can be so merciful and that he has forgiven you. If only you would listen, hear and believe him. Our Lord graciously tells us not to be afraid, not to let our hearts be troubled but to listen and believe that he truly is the way, the truth and the life that sets us free, so stop disbelieving and believe. Now that you know the truth, stay and let Jesus heal you with the truth that sets you free.



St. Bartholomew, Apostle - August 24th



We honor St. Bartholomew, one of the original twelve apostles. He was the "Nathaniel" in the Gospel of St. John, who was brought to Jesus by Philip. A note in "The Liturgy of the Hours" says that he was born in Cana, and the Roman Martyrology tells us that he

preached the gospel in India as well as in Armenia, where he was flayed alive and then beheaded.

On feasts of the apostles, we are always reminded of a characteristic virtue of these first followers of Jesus, namely their zeal. These men ventured forth, filled with the Holy Spirit, to proclaim the salvation won for us by Jesus. St. John Chrysostom explains this zeal by saying that the Holy Spirit enlightened them as to the meaning of the Cross.

He wrote: "It was clear through unlearned men that the cross was persuasive, in fact, it persuaded the whole world. Paul had this in mind when he said: 'The weakness of God is stronger than men.' That the preaching of these men was indeed divine is brought home to us in the same way. For how otherwise could twelve uneducated men, who lived on lakes and rivers and wastelands, get the idea for such an immense enterprise? How could men who perhaps had never been in a city or a public square think of setting out to do battle with the whole world?"

The apostles were witnesses of the resurrection of Jesus and for this reason were driven men. Zeal, at any rate, is a driving power or an emotion at work, and in the apostles of Jesus was motivated by a very pure love of God. It was in them a virtue devoid of any selfishness.

Their zeal is a reminder and a challenge for us to be active witnesses to Jesus' power over us. Zeal in us is supported by our faith, and in turn sustains our faith. May it "sustain within us the faith which made St. Bartholomew ever loyal to Christ," so that we also may be a "sign of salvation for all the nations" of our world. (CF Collect of Mass)

Abortion Amendment to Florida's Constitution

Vote 'No' on Amendment 4

The Church plays a role in the promotion and attainment of justice and protection of the common good. As faithful citizens, we are called to participate in public life and to apply Gospel values to our political activities. Our actions in the public square must reflect the values of our faith and demonstrate a fundamental belief in the dignity of every person and the sacredness of all human life.

A proposed amendment to our state constitution that seeks to legalize abortion through the third trimester will appear on the November 2024 ballot. While Catholic opposition to abortion is well known, even our friends and neighbors who would tolerate abortion to some degree are finding the proposed amendment too extreme and even deceptive. Let me explain a few key components of the Amendment:

- This amendment was cleverly worded to hide the fact that it would eliminate current laws
 and common-sense safety regulations for abortions that most people on both sides of this
 issue support. For example, while the amendment allows for parental <u>notification</u> before
 a daughter undergoes an abortion, it would eliminate the current law that requires parental
 <u>consent</u>, making this the only medical decision for which parents have no say.
- The amendment explicitly allows abortion until the preborn child is viable, which is at about 22-24 weeks, or 6 months, of pregnancy. It then provides a loophole to allow "health care providers," which under Florida law do not have to be doctors, to justify practically any abortion after that point. Even employees of abortion clinics who are not doctors would be able to approve late-term abortions.
- Unlike other proposed constitutional amendments, the text of the amendment does not define key terms like "government interference," "viability," "patient's health" and "health care provider." Without these definitions, the amendment, if passed, will cause countless lawsuits and years of legal uncertainty.

The bishops of Florida have urged all Floridians to pray for protections for the preborn and mothers in need, and to stand against the legalization of late-term abortion by voting 'no' on Amendment 4.
