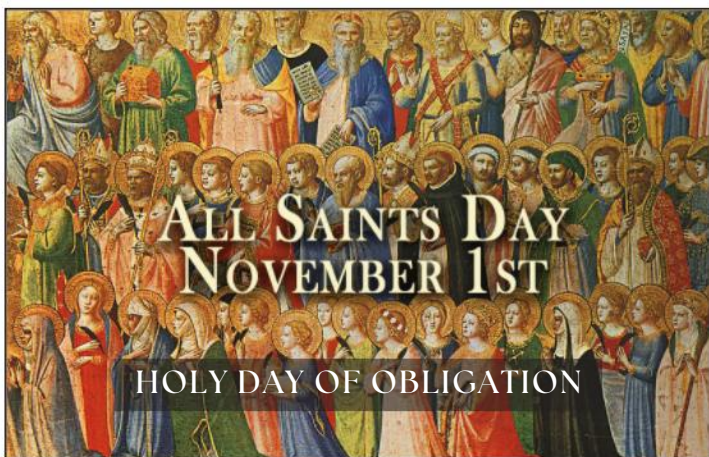

## REFLECTIONS FROM THE HEART

by Fr. Ivan

Many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he kept calling out all the more, "Son of David, have pity on me." What does salvation look like, or sound like to you. What do you hope it will provide you if you receive it? Would you recognize salvation's voice? Would you recognize his face if you saw him? Do you know who you are listening to, the place and direction that person is leading you to? Is it to the place flowing with milk and honey, the land God promised you, heavenly, eternal, your salvation? Or is it to that place of unquenchable thirst, the land God warned you about, eternal desolation, your damnation? Do you want to be saved, need to be saved, hope to be saved? Do you know, believe and recognize the One who says to you in the Eucharist, in the confessional, through his poor priests, "go in peace, your sins have been forgiven." Would you recognize the face of mercy, the voice of reason, the words of absolution, the gift of freedom, the source of your salvation? Listening is such a blessed gift. It is the key and the doorway to your salvation and the grace of entering more fully into the blessed everlasting relationship with the One who created and sustains you, the One who saved and redeemed you, the One who sanctifies and blesses you. Listening attentively to the One who speaks tenderly to you alleviates the worry and stress associated with sinfulness. It takes away the fear and the anxiety of worrying, stressing and wondering will I be saved? Will someone be coming to help me, to my assistance, to my aid? Will someone be coming into my life, into my daily situation, to my assistance and save me? Will I ever be free again, at peace again, happy again? Will I see my loved ones once more or spend an eternity alone, punished, enslaved, paying for my sins over and over again? Listening is the answer to your prayer, the hope your petition is heard, your cry noticed, your calling out and pleading worthwhile. Listening provides the instruction you need to hear, the direction you need to take, the information you have been waiting for, everything you hope for and so much more. Listening to God provides the help we long for, the aid we asked for, the assistance we so desperately need. Don't be afraid to call out "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me" but listen for his voice saying, "I forgive you, go in peace."

## CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

### Catechism Corner

"Hope is expressed and nourished in prayer, especially in the Our Father, the summary of everything that hope leads us to desire."

**1820** Christian hope unfolds from the beginning of Jesus' preaching in the proclamation of the beatitudes. The beatitudes raise our hope toward heaven as the new Promised Land; they trace the path that leads through the trials that await the disciples of Jesus. But through the merits of Jesus Christ and of his Passion, God keeps us in the "hope that does not disappoint." Hope is the "sure and steadfast anchor of the soul . . . that enters . . . where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf." Hope is also a weapon that protects us in the struggle of salvation: "Let us . . . put on the breastplate of faith and charity, and for a helmet the hope of salvation." It affords us joy even under trial: "Rejoice in your hope, be patient in tribulation."

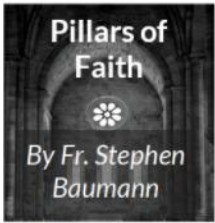

## St. Callistus I, Pope and Martyr – October 14

Congratulations to our Girls Varsity Basketball team for bringing home the League Championship! Our Boys Varsity and JV Soccer teams had undefeated seasons and came in second in their Championship games. We are proud of all of our fall STAR athletes.

The life and career of St. Callistus I is an interesting story with no dull moments. As a slave, he was entrusted with business responsibilities by his Christian owner. When the business failed, Callistus fled, but was brought back and sent to work on a treadmill. After he was released, he was arrested in a brawl in a synagogue and sent to work in the mines. After he was freed, he made his way back to Rome. Pope St. Zephyrinus, knowing his administrative skills, ordained him a deacon and later he was elected to succeed Zephyrinus.

The priest Hippolytus refused to recognize his election, had himself elected and consecrated a bishop, and was thus the first anti-pope. This schism was resolved some eighteen years later when Hippolytus was reconciled by Pope St. Pontian while both were in exile. Later, Hippolytus was martyred and honored as a saint.

At any rate, Callistus' five years as bishop of Rome were as stormy as his earlier life. He took a moderate stance in some doctrinal disputes and advocated leniency in some disciplinary matters. In each instance, he was opposed by the rigorous stand of Hippolytus and his followers. Callistus maintained that the Church was a home for sinners as well as saints, and therefore offered reconciliation to those who had fallen into any sin after baptism. His view became the norm in the discipline of Penance in the Church.

St. Callistus I died in a local disturbance in the year 222 A.D. Whether he is a true martyr is disputed, since there was no persecution at the time, but he was honored as a martyr in the earliest martyrology.

A thought for today, from a treatise by St. Cyprian of Carthage: "If persecution should overtake a soldier of God, it will not overcome one so virtuously prepared for battle. Even if our summons should come sooner, our faith which was prepared for the witness of martyrdom will not go unrewarded. For we would immediately receive our reward by God's judgment. In time of persecution, the battle wins the crown, but in peace it is the testimony of a good conscience."

From our history we do not know the interior spirituality of St. Callistus I, but he was a capable bishop and his actions as bishop show an understanding of the charity and gentleness of Christ. (Note: for a more detailed yet brief account of the life and papacy of St. Callistus I, see J.N.D. Kelly, "The Oxford Dictionary of Popes.")
