## Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary


On Monday, December 9th we will have Mass at 7am, 12:15pm and 7pm. *Holy Day of Obligation. There is no Vigil Mass*

## REFLECTIONS FROM THE HEART

"Brothers and sisters: May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all." One of the most profound statements and acknowledgements in sacred scripture occurs when Saint John the Baptist is hit and faced with the reality that he must decrease so that Jesus can increase in the lives of others. It is our call, our duty, our salvation as fellow Christians that we also must, not should or could or maybe, but rather must decrease so that God can increase his Son's ministries in us; so that our truest identity as Christians may rise from the darkness of error and sin into the glorious freedom of the Children of Light. Light must increase so that darkness and evil can scatter. Love must increase so indifference and hate can leave this world. A desire for life must increase in our lives and hearts so that sin and death can be no more. You must decrease in order for the Kingdom of God to manifest itself and rid itself of the sinful evil kingdom and its destructive desire to destroy all of God's children. You must decrease; Christ must increase in you so that the Kingdom of God here, there, and everywhere in your life, in your heart, in your family, in your Christian ministries and duties can be visible, accessible and present to all, for the good of all but more perfectly for love of Christ and for love of one another. In order for something to increase, something must decrease. In order to add; we must subtract. We cannot not be of the mindset that we can keep remodeling our hearts, expanding the space, adding to it by building a shed or attaching more garage space or by adding a new addition. We cannot continue to occupy more storage space but must empty ourselves, free ourselves of what is displacing God. We must make more room for Christ who has made you his home, his dwelling place, his house of prayer. We simply cannot keep stuffing our hearts like stocking stuffers but must make room, more room and more space in our hearts for Christ to live, to move, to breathe and minister in, through and with us throughout our lives. Can we have a little less anger and abound more in Christ's love? Can we temper down our bad attitudes and increase more in faith, hope, love and trust? Can we decrease in sinful activities so that the Lord can increase in us his virtue, holiness, grace?








**The Breaking**  
**of the Oplatek**



In many Polish homes throughout the world, a beloved family tradition is the breaking of the oplatek on Christmas Eve. Oplatek is a thin wafer made from flour and water similar in taste and consistency to the hosts that are used for communion during Mass. Oplatki are often stamped with an elaborate Christmas scene.

The oplatek is meant to remind families of the Eucharistic bread at Mass and makes a further connection between Christmas and the gift of the Eucharist, the presence of God among us.





## St. Margaret of Scotland

St. Margaret of Scotland (1046-1093) was Hungarian by birth, raised at the court of St. Stephen, King of Hungary, and later brought to England. Having to flee there after the Battle of Hastings, she was shipwrecked off the coast of Scotland. She and her family were welcomed by King Malcolm, whom Margaret married, four years later, about 1070 A.D.

Their married life was blessed; they had eight children. Margaret was able to help Malcolm be a virtuous king and she was his trusted advisor. Together they practiced austerities and were generous to the poor and needy, often ministering to them personally. Margaret took great personal interest in the religious and spiritual life of the people, urging synods to correct the prevalent abuses of simony (the buying and selling of church offices), usury (excessive interest charged on loans), and marriage between close relatives. Margaret died at Edinburgh in 1093, an ideal mother and queen.

St. Margaret's holiness in marriage is brought to mind through one of the readings in the Divine Office. From the Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World, of the Second Vatican Council, we read:

"Husband and wife, by the covenant of marriage, are no longer two, but one flesh. By their intimate union of persons and actions they give mutual help and service to each other, experiencing the meaning of their unity, and gain an ever deeper understanding of it day by day."

Also, "This intimate union in the mutual self-giving of two persons, as well as the good of the children, demands full fidelity from both, and an indissoluble unity between them."

"Christ the Lord has abundantly blessed this richly complex love, which springs from the divine source of love and is founded on the model of His union with the Church." (Gaudium et Spes, n.48).

St. Margaret of Scotland understood that being a truly fulfilled woman meant freedom to love God and to serve others. "May her example and prayers help us to become living signs of God's goodness." (Collect of Mass).


