


### REFLECTIONS FROM THE HEART



"Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you." Darkness has a way of creeping into our lives unnoticed, as if it was unassuming, unobtrusive and did not want to bother you in any way. However, darkness is unwelcomed, is sneaky, and wants to invade your entire joyous life with unprecedented deception, hidden unnatural passions and unruly disorderly desires. Darkness wants to cover you all over and smother you inside and out with darkness so that the True Light that has come into the world to save you cannot and will never reach you. Darkness wants nothing more than to disrupt your unending joy and bring an unhappy ending to your blessed happiness. True darkness hates pure light. Darkness would rather go into further darkness than admit it is wrong. It will never give way to the True Light, the Light of Life, the Light that has come into the world. Darkness wishes, hopes and diabolically plans and plots to obliterate any further hope you may have of being in the love and watchful, constant care of God who is eternal and wants nothing more than to watchfully care for you and love you totally today, yesterday and forever more. #### St. Peter Canisius, Priest & Doctor

St. Peter Canisius (1521-1597) is sometimes called "the second apostle of Germany." He is a very important person in the Catholic Counter Reformation which followed the sixteenth century Council of Trent, several sessions of which he had attended.

Born in Nijmegen in the Netherlands, he entered the Society of Jesus after studying at Cologne and Louvain. He was ordained a priest in 1546 and was first given a teaching assignment. As he was noted for his preaching, Duke William of Bavaria asked that he be sent to Germany to revive Catholicism. A popular and eloquent preacher, he zealously defended the Faith, authored a simple catechism, taught and established colleges and seminaries. His influence was widespread and lasting.

Prior to his assignment to Germany, St. Peter Canisius tells of a spiritual experience. After acknowledging his acceptance of that mission, he continued:

"At length, it was as if you opened to me the heart in your most sacred body; I seemed to see it directly before my eyes. You told me to drink from this fountain, inviting me, that is, to draw the waters of salvation from your wellsprings, my Savior. I was most eager that streams of faith, hope and love should flow into me from that source. I was thirsting for poverty, chastity, obedience. I asked to be clothed, to be wholly cleaned by you, to be made resplendent by you.

"So, after daring to approach your most loving heart and to plunge my thirst in it, I received a promise from you of a garment made of three parts: "these were to cover my soul in its nakedness, and to belong especially to my religious profession. They were peace, love and perseverance. Protected by this garment of salvation, I was confident that I would lack nothing, but all would succeed and give you glory." (Cf. 2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

St. Peter Canisius was canonized in 1925 and declared a Doctor of the Church. The Antiphon in the Benedictus (Morning Prayer) reads: "Those who are learned will be as radiant as the sky in all its beauty; those who instruct the people in goodness will shine like the stars for all eternity."

# CHALKING THE DOOR The Epiphany House Blessing

"Chalking the door" is a centuries-old custom in which Christians gather on the feast of the Epiphany to ask God's blessing on their home. A traditional way of doing this is to take a piece of blessed chalk and inscribe above the entrance door to the home.

## 20+C+M+B+25

The "20" and "25" refer to the actual year. The "+" between the letters symbolizes the cross of Christ.

The "C M B" initials have two meanings:

- The initials represent the three Magi: Casper, Melchior and Balthazar.
- Also, the initials abbreviate the Latin "Christus Mansionem Benedict" (May Christ bless this house).



The Universal Church celebrates the Jubilee Year 2025 - the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord.

Pope Francis stated in his February 2022 letter announcing the Jubilee 2025: "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision. The forthcoming Jubilee can contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust as a prelude to the renewal and rebirth that we so urgently desire..."

#### The opening of the Holy Door

The opening of the Holy Door by the Pope marks the beginning of the Jubilee. The Holy Year of 2025 includes this ritual, followed by the celebration of Holy Mass on Christmas Eve inside St. Peter's Basilica. The inner wall sealing the Holy Door was recently dismantled, and the metal box containing the key to open the door was retrieved. The Pope symbolically pushes the door open, while the traditional use of a hammer to strike the brick seal on the outside has been discontinued for safety reasons. After the ceremony, the door remains open for the entire year to allow pilgrims to pass through. This gesture signifies a complete experience of the indulgence associated with the Holy Year.

Crossing this threshold also symbolizes the journey of conversion, sealed by the encounter with Christ, the "door", uniting us with the Father. The Jubilees are part of a profound history of faith that opens its doors to the world—a journey in which the steps of the Pontiff join those of the people of God, along the paths of forgiveness.




