


REFLECTIONS FROM THE HEART

by Fr. Ivan

"Every tree is known by its own fruit." One of the most profound things that Jesus has said to us, actually, one of the most profound things he has ever said to me is, "remain in me, as I remain in you." How can the mystery of this great gift even be so remotely possible, the impossibility of remaining forever? Contemplate it, a God that cannot be contained in time or limited in any way by his creation chooses to live in you, reside in you, to remain in you, a poor sinner who still sins every day and is probably sinning this very moment, and yet this awesome God chooses to remain with you and actively remain in you. This type of remaining is ongoing. It continues to be. It is something that is constant and consistent. Remaining actively in the presence and person of God. It is always happening, not changing but rather remaining. Not like an attachment or an accessory that can change and interchange but rather permanently like a branch that remains on a vine that actively remains in love and in the love of God. A branch needs the vine to provide constantly and consistently the nourishment it needs to grow, flower then bear fruit with the help of the vine. The sustenance, energy, food, water, strength, shelter to bear good fruit that is pleasing to the Father. Always actively remaining in trust with God. Actively remaining in Holy Communion with God. Actively choosing in every moment circumstance to remain actively in the life and the loving gaze of the Father, by actively doing so through the loving grace of the Son and by actively remaining in the gift of the Holy Spirit. Just as surprising is to note and mention that the vine also needs the branch to receive the gracious gifts that pour out from the vine into the branch to bear fruit. The vine needs the branch to hold and carry the fruit. The vine needs the branch to flower and nectar and visibly reveal the goodness and wholesomeness, the sacred fragrance of the vine. It is a mutual act of mutually sharing and actively remaining in the loving relationship established in creation by the Father, continued in redemption by the Son and perpetually enriched by the gift and fruits of the Holy Spirit. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit, united in a bond of trust and charity all choose to remain always in and with us. What will you actively choose? To remain or to regret?

St. Peter Damian, Bishop & Doctor

Orphaned when very young, Peter was mistreated by the brother in whose charge he was placed. He was rescued however by another brother who was archpriest of Ravenna, and who saw to his education. Peter became an excellent teacher, and out of his own experience developed a sensitivity to the poor, sharing all of what he had with them. Even prior to his resolve to become a monk, he fasted, prayed for long hours and undertook other disciplines.

Eventually he joined a community of hermits and became abbot about the year 1043. From that time on he was called upon to be a peacemaker and settle disputes among religious and civil authorities. In 1057 he was appointed Cardinal-Bishop of Ostia, and reluctantly came out of his solitary life. Throughout his life he made Christ and the service of the Church his first love.

Later, when he was permitted to resign his see (diocese) and return to his monastic life, he continued to write and to work for reform of the Church. His concerns were to rid the Church of simony (the buying and selling of indulgences) to correct the laxity of clergy and religious, and to heal various schisms that broke out.

From Peter Damian's writings we come to some understanding of the asceticism (practices of self-denial) of his time. In the article, "The Gregorian Reform," by Karl F. Morrison, we read "Cardinal Peter Damian described how he combined mortification of the will and body as a practice while reciting penitential psalms and prayers. Such practices were designed to intensify devotion and fervor, particularly the sense of sharing in the poverty and sufferings of Christ." (Christian Spirituality: Origins to the Twelfth Century, p. 189).

From Peter Damian's own writings we have: "When men suffer pain for the evil they have perpetrated in life, they should take some reassurance. They also know that for their good deeds undying rewards await them in the life to come. The way that God deals with men can only be praised. He allows them to suffer in this life to shield them from suffering in the next. He pins them down before healing; He throws them down in order to raise them anew." (From his letter; Liturgy of the Hours; 2nd Reading).

That was the spirituality and asceticism of the time. We do not embrace today everything that motivated St. Peter Damian, such as harsh penances, but we understand him in the light of his time in the tenth and eleventh centuries. We cannot fault him for his vision, zeal, and self-discipline.

Today we prefer to preach about the virtue of love in the saints' lives. The language of today is different, but the goal is the same. "By making Christ and the service of his Church the first love of our lives," we ask that we may "come to the joys of eternal light," by following the "teachings and example of St. Peter Damian."


