




REFLECTIONS FROM THE HEART

by Fr. Ivan

"For to his angels he has given command about you, that they guard you in all your ways." Would you consider yourself self-directed or spiritually directed? It is an important point and question to consider for your own happiness is at stake as well as ours. One direction clearly points us to God and carries with it a joyful disposition, the expectation of an answered prayer and a glorious freedom of spirit that even in uncertain moments still breathes hope and trust even in the darkness of evil and the darkest of times. The other direction tends to bring with it an all-consuming, never ending sadness. It breathes bitter confusion to all and to all surroundings. It causes an unquenchable dissatisfaction in our lives and the lives of others causing us to want more, however, we sell out and settle for less. Some people we encounter in our dayto-day claim by words or witness or even by their own testimony or confession to be spiritual in being or spiritually fed and led. However, by their own action and outward appearance and deeds they prove to be self-reliant and independent even though they pray and are spiritual in nature but in true life, they remain self-directed. The choices they make, the intentions that flow from their hearts, the preferences that follow their own decisions are self-interested, self-suggested and self-motivated hence, they are self-directed even though they pray. Sometimes we pray in a spirit of discernment when in actuality we have already made a choice, we already have a preference and we have already made a decision. We pray not to know God's wisdom or to know God's preference or will, or his thought or input. We know what we want. We have already determined how the decision should be implemented and even have a preference in the delivery of the goods and the expected due date. All we need is God to bend his will to ours. We manipulate the prayer. We negotiate with our Creator. That does not sound spiritual in nature even though you prayed. Not being self-centered or selfishly directed and not being self-motivated in discernment but rather spiritually open and welcoming is to allow God the freedom, space and authority to utilize his infinite wisdom and his loving desire to will the greatest good for you. To choose the best possible outcome and decision for you in order to bring about the greatest possible happiness for your sake, your family and that of the whole world. Trust God. He cares for you.







St. Katherine Drexel

As a wealthy young woman, at age 20, Katharine Drexel (1858-1955), decided to use her considerable inheritance for the benefit of the poor. Her stepmother, Emma Bouvier, was a definite influence on her life, both with respect to her piety and her love and concern for the poor. In her early 20's Katharine began to think of a religious vocation. After the death of her father, she and her sister began to use their wealth to help others.

At first counselled to continue her philanthropic work outside religious life, Katharine, at a private audience with Pope Leo XIII, in 1887, spoke of the need to have more priests work with the American Indians. The pope's response to her was a surprise: "Why not, my child, yourself become a missionary?"

Upon returning home Katherine accompanied Bishop James O'Connor of Omaha on a tour of western missions. A year later she decided to become a religious sister and entered the novitiate program of the Sisters of Mercy. However, on February 12, 1891, Katharine made final vows as the first Sister of the Blessed Sacrament for Indian and Colored People.

Her life's work lay ahead of her and for the next forty years she directed the work of her Congregation of Sisters. By the year 1935 when Katharine suffered a heart attack, the Sisters had 49 foundations (missions) in the west and the south.

Throughout her life, Katharine was a deeply religious woman and a model of piety (prayerfulness). Her declining health and the subsequent necessity to turn over her administrative duties to others finally allowed her more time for the contemplation to which she was originally attracted in religious life.

On November 20, 1988 she was beatified by Pope St. John Paul II who spoke of her life as one "of exceptional apostolic service." In his homily at the Mass of Beatification, the Holy Father said "she was a woman of lively faith, deeply committed to the truth revealed by Christ, the truth she knew so well because she constantly listened to Christ's voice."

Much of Katharine's spiritual strength was drawn from the Blessed Sacrament, as Pope St. John Paul II noted: "She was always eager to deepen her love for Jesus, whom she received and adored each day in the Eucharist. Her union with Christ the King gave her confidence that whatever was done in His name would bear much fruit for the sake of the Kingdom."

Her last twenty years of life were quiet and intense, as she prayed in a small room overlooking the sanctuary. Small notebooks and slips of paper record her various prayers, ceaseless aspirations, and meditations. She died at the age of 96, and was canonized by Pope St. John Paul II in the year 2000.

It is our privilege to remember and honor one of our own, American St. Katharine Drexel, who lived so close to our place and time. She was a virtuous, holy woman whose zeal for the Faith was nourished by her contemplation of the Word.


