REFLECTIONS FROM THE HEART

by Fr. Ivan

"Behold, I make all things new." Most of us, given an opportunity to do so, can from our early childhood years of catechetical instruction and teaching or through the sacramental formation we received, easily recite, probably word for word, the classical definition of what is a sacrament: "The sacraments are efficacious signs of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church, by which divine life is dispensed to us." Nevertheless, what does that mean? What does that mean to you? How would you respond to the text? How would you describe what a sacrament is in your own words? Where is God leading you in thought and heart to consider explaining a sacrament to a child, a neighbor, a person who does not believe or to a person who has lost all hope but wants and needs to believe? Where is God graciously inviting you today to grow, know, change or simply be inspired? Given my own lack of intellectual wisdom, knowledge, and comprehension and in the little ways that I can provide any sort of explanation or can claim any confidence of understanding a textbook definition, I probably would complicate the matter and add further confusion to any definition. Thankful that God has graciously helped me to understand sacraments in simple terms and in a simple language that I can understand and in a language I can share: a sacrament is simply a life giving, lifesaving and lifechanging gift from God to make us new again. When we encounter Jesus in his real presence and the gift of sacramental grace, we simply are not the same. How can anyone who truly encounters the real presence of Jesus remain unchanged? We are touched by God, changed by grace, transformed by love, made into a new creation. God makes all things new. He renews us and makes us new in, through and with the sacraments. The Church teaches us that Jesus himself, through and in the power, peace and unity of the Holy Spirit, graciously bestows himself and celebrates the sacraments with and in us. It is Jesus who truly baptized and confirmed you. In and through his poor priests, Jesus consecrates you and gives himself freely as gift to you. Jesus sanctifies you and sacramentally feeds and nourishes you in Holy Communion and through special graces in, and through and with the Blessed Sacrament, the Holy Eucharist, with his Precious Body and Blood conforms you, heals you, loves you, transforms you, restores you, makes you good, holy and new once again; a living sacrament.

I am pleased to appoint Father Matthew Hawkins pastor of Annunciation Catholic Church, effective June 1. Father Hawkins is returning to his 'home parish,' Annunciation Catholic Church.



Born in Miami, his family moved to Orlando when he was 7 months old, and he considers himself an Orlando native. He and his sister were raised in the Presbyterian Church. He received a bachelor's degree in computer science and engineering from the University of Florida. He was introduced to the Catholic Church during his later years of college, when a friend invited him to join him at the celebration of Mass. That invitation was the beginning of the transfiguration of Matthew Hawkins. He said, "It was Christ for whom I had always been searching...and I knew I wanted to give my life totally to Him, in service to the people and living always in the presence of God." After graduation from St. Vincent de Paul Major Seminary, Bishop John Noonan ordained Father Matthew Hawkins on May 26, 2018, in St. James Cathedral. He is 48 years old

After Ordination, Father Hawkins served as parochial vicar of St. James Cathedral, Orlando; and in 2021 as parochial administrator, then named pastor of St. Paul Catholic Church, Leesburg in 2022. While serving the parishioners of St. James Cathedral, he also served as director of ecumenism for the Diocese of Orlando.

Father Hawkins prays that all the people might come to know, love and serve God and one another through, with and in our triune God. He will invite you, good people of Annunciation Catholic Church, to be faith-filled and embrace the Lord by your daily living. Welcome Father Matthew Hawkins with an open heart as he responds to Jesus, "Lord you know I love you," and comes to feed you with the Gift of Finest Wheat.



St. Matthias, Apostle - May 14

The only mention of St. Matthias in Scripture is in the Acts of the Apostles. The passage we read tells us how he came to be numbered among the apostles (Acts 1:15-26). They drew lots to determine the next apostle, "The choice fell to Matthias, who was added to the eleven apostles."

Legend says that Matthias preached in Judea, Cappadocia (present day Turkey) and on the shores of the Caspian Sea, where he was martyred.

The Opening Prayer or Collect of the Mass says that St. Matthias was called by the Father "to share in the mission of the apostles." That mission was to give witness to the resurrection of Jesus. Peter said to the disciples –about 120 were gathered together – that one of their company should be named as witness with the apostles to Jesus' resurrection.

St. John Chrysostom explained this passage in a homily. "Peter did not say 'a witness to the rest of His actions' but only a 'witness of the resurrection." The rest of Jesus' action, the signs and wonders were known by general admission. Many disciples and non-disciples witnessed these; they had taken place openly. "But the resurrection took place secretly."

Peter prayed that the Lord would make his choice known, for as St. John Chrysostom said "they did not feel themselves worthy to make the choice of their own accord, and therefore they wanted some sign for their instruction."

So we are to understand that the call to be an apostle is a privileged grace, a call by God, and an act of God. Our call to the Christian life is also specific and personal. At baptism we are called first by name, and we are to continue the mission of the apostles and be witnesses to Christ today. Our faith in the resurrection of Jesus gives meaning and significance to our lives. We have been chosen "to go forth and to bear much fruit."
