REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL

Many things in life are not fair. Children are keenly aware of this any time they sense they have been cheated by a sibling. They complain to their parents, just as the person in the crowd quoted in the Gospel complained to Jesus about his brother. We want justice and can become quite upset when we feel that we have been dealt an injustice.

The Gospel passage is interesting because Jesus gently but clearly refuses to be the arbiter of justice for this man. It may indeed be the case that he was cheated out of his inheritance by his brother. But it's interesting that Jesus not only refuses to resolve the dispute, He then goes on to teach about greed, suggesting that the cheated man was acting out of greed.


If you were cheated out of your inheritance by a sibling, how would you react? If a sibling were to do this, it would clearly be a sin and an injustice. But the question at hand is your reaction to being cheated. Being cheated by another might result in one of two responses. The most common response is to immediately seek justice, to fight back. But this is not always what God will inspire us to do. Instead, when we experience injustice, we are given an opportunity to love on a very deep level. And this must be our response. This is why Jesus said we must love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us. In the big picture of eternity, earthly injustices are always an opportunity for grace. This is evident by simply looking at the gravest injustice of the suffering and death of the Son of God. Jesus did not complain about being so cruelly treated. He did not call on the angels of Heaven to destroy the Pharisees and Romans who attacked Him. Instead, Jesus used the injustice inflicted upon Him as a foundation for His gift of salvation.

As we journey through this life, we need to decide whether we are going to live for this life or for eternity. We cannot have both. However, by choosing to live for eternity, we also enhance our lives here on earth in ways that nothing in this world can match. For example, say you experienced the unfortunate situation of extreme poverty. Say you were cheated out of your home and possessions and were left with nothing. Would this make you miserable? It might, but it doesn't have to. Instead, such an unfortunate circumstance has the potential for you to live day-by-day, trusting in God's providential care and to offer mercy in the face of injustice. And that is good. It is good for your eternal soul. It is good because it will motivate you to trust God on a very deep level and to become a beacon of God's mercy. By contrast, if you had everything you could ever want in this world, it would be seriously tempting to rely less upon God and more upon the things you possess in this world. But the things of this world cannot save your eternal soul. In fact, they are a serious hindrance to your ability to trust in God alone. So, truth be told, poverty and injustice actually open the door to an opportunity for much more grace in our lives than material wealth does. But so often we still long to have more and more of the things of this world.

Life is not Always Fair

Life is not always fair. Kids know this well especially when a brother or sister gets more than they do. They run to their parents and say, "That's not fair!" Just like a man in the Bible went to Jesus and said his brother cheated him.

But Jesus did not fix the problem the way the man wanted. Instead, He talked about the danger of being greedy. Jesus showed that even when we are treated unfairly, what matters most is how we choose to act.

If your brother or sister cheated you, how would you feel? Most people would want to fight back right away. But Jesus teaches us something harder—and better. He says we should love even our enemies and pray for those who hurt us.

When bad things happen, it's a chance to show deep love and trust in God. Jesus showed us this on the Cross. Even though people treated Him very cruelly, He did not fight back. Instead, He used that moment to bring us the gift of salvation.

So we must decide: will we live only for this world, or will we live for God and forever with Him in Heaven? If we only care about money and things, we may forget to trust God. But if we trust Him, even when life is unfair, we will grow closer to Him.

Remember: all the things in this world will one day pass away. But God's love lasts forever. So when you face something unfair, ask God to help you love, forgive, and trust Him more. That way, you will gain the true treasure - eternal life with Him.

St. Lawrence of Brindisi, Priest & Doctor



After reading about St. Lawrence of Brindisi (1559-1619) in various dictionaries of saints and commentaries in various sources, one has to be impressed by the talent and energy of this saint. Well educated in philosophy and theology at the University of Padua, one of the great medieval schools, he was ordained a priest at age 23. His brilliant use of sacred scripture in preaching was soon recognized. He was an accomplished linguist, fluent in the biblical languages as well as the major languages of continental Europe.

Recognized in addition to his theological brilliance was his "human compassion and administrative skills," which served him well as Minister General of his Order, and on the many peace-keeping missions he undertook for the Pope and several monarchs of his day. "Lawrence had a balance in his life that was able to blend self-discipline with a keen appreciation for the needs of those whom he was called to serve." This was true of his ministry in the Church, in his religious order, and as arbiter in many political disputes and threatening situations.


His first love and his greatest talent was his preaching in which he used the Scriptures with great skill. In one of his sermons, he said: "For the word of God is a light to the mind and a fire to the will. It enables man to know God and to love him. And for the interior man who lives by the Spirit of God through grace, it is bread and water...For the soul it is a spiritual treasure of merits yielding an abundance of gold and precious stones. Against the hardness of heart that persists in wrongdoing, it acts as a hammer. Against the world, the flesh and the devil it serves as a sword that destroys all sin." (2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

We pray today through the intercession of St. Lawrence of Brindisi, Doctor (teacher) of the Church, "to know what we should do and have the courage to do it." (Collect for Mass).


The Transfiguration | Sacred Art

Food Pantry Update

We started last school year with approximately 50 backpacks of food distributed to local elementary schools in a 5 mile radius of Annunciation. We ended the school year with 98 and an increase of 3 schools. Next month we will start this new school year with 120 backpacks. It's truly a blessing that our Food Outreach can help so many families in these very challenging times. We supply backpacks weekly for food-insecure children to take home to offset hunger on the weekends.

The Third Grade class from the Academy comes to the pantry a total of 4 times throughout the school year. They learn about the needs of other children and truly get a passion for wanting to help those less fortunate. They learn about food safety and how to stock the pantry and they pack backpacks, which they love to do. This all culminates with a food drive at the Academy for all grades, spearheaded by Third Grade! We are thankful for their kind, giving hearts.

Large food distributions are scheduled for the third Friday in August, September and October. This is a huge undertaking in conjunction with Second Harvest and The Sharing Center. We serve 30k pounds of food, including frozen protein and produce to over 350 families! Please consider joining us to serve our community. It's very rewarding!

We are very blessed to have several food drives scheduled for before each mass with the first one August 2/3. Your generosity and kindness blesses our neighbors and specifically young children.... thank you.
