## Congratulations on the Rite of Candidacy!

My name is Krys Tetterton. My wife Kim, and children Kaylinh and Dylan, have been parishioners here since 2018. Over the last 3 years, I have been in formation for the Permanent Diaconate in the Diocese of Orlando. This past weekend, Father Matthew joined us at a Mass with Bishop Noonan as he blessed myself and my fellow Diaconate Candidates with the Rite of Candidacy. The Rite of Candidacy for permanent deacons is a formal ceremony where a man publicly declares his intention to pursue ordination as a deacon, and the Church recognizes him as a candidate.

Here at our Annunciation home, our family has been fortunate enough to participate in multiple ministries. We have worked with many of your children in Faith Formation, and walked the path to initiation through OCIA. I've even coached a soccer game or two for our ACA Stars!

God willing, as our family continues on this path towards ordination in 2028, we humbly ask for your prayers, as we pray for you and this incredible community that has supported us.



## REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL

Jesus said "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" (Luke 12:49) The "fire" of which He speaks is His purifying fire of mercy that He poured forth from the Cross as He offered His life for the salvation of the world. His mercy is given to free us from our sins and to cleanse our souls so that God Himself can come to dwell within us. This is why we exist. God wants to dwell within us, and He wants us to be in perfect union with Him.

One of the glorious effects of uniting yourself to God is that this union also brings about a spiritual bond with others who are united to God. We are made for communion with God, but also for communion with each other. God especially invites family members to share in this unity. Though there are many levels of friendship and unity we can have with each other, the deepest bonds come from two souls each being united to God. For example, two people may both like the same sports team or have the same interests, resulting in a bond or form of friendship. This is good. But when each of those friends also is deeply united to God, the unity comes from God and not from something more superficial.

The challenging Gospel passage above reveals to us what happens when one or more members of a household fail to open themselves to the cleansing fire of God's love and, therefore, fail to live in union with God. The result is disunity, at least on the deepest and truest level. God is not the cause of disunity; sin is. When one person is united to God and another is immersed in a life of sin, true spiritual unity is not possible. Of course the two might still share some common interests and might even superficially get along each day, but there will never be an experience of authentic spiritual friendship and communion if God is absent from one or both hearts.

When Jesus says that He has come to establish division within a household, He is simply pointing out that there will indeed be a division within a household when all are not united to God. Additionally, Jesus is warning us that if someone within our household tries to draw us into a life of sin with them, that person's invitation must be rejected. And when that happens, that rejection is often experienced as a rejection of the person and results in even greater disunity. The bottom line is that it is not possible to be authentically united in sin or any form of lie.

Reflect, today, upon the deepest spiritual desire you have. If you are honest with yourself, you will discover that this deepest desire in your heart is the desire for love. We are made to give and receive love. First, this desire is fulfilled by opening ourselves to the love of God. When that happens, we will be able to share God's love with others and receive God's love from them. Nothing in life could be more fulfilling than this.

## **Open Our Hearts to His Love**

Jesus said, "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" (Luke 12:49)

The fire Jesus talks about is His love and mercy. He gave this to us when He died on the Cross to save the world. His mercy washes away our sins and makes our hearts clean so that God can live inside us. This is why we are here—God wants to live in us, and He wants us to be close to Him.

When we are close to God, we are also joined in a special way to others who love God. God made us to be close to Him and to each other. Families are meant to share this closeness. People can be friends because they like the same things, like a sport or hobby. But the best friendship is when both people love God. That kind of friendship comes from God Himself.

Sometimes, people in the same family do not love or follow God. This can cause sadness and trouble. God is not the one who causes the trouble—sin does. If one person follows God and another chooses sin, they can't be truly close in their hearts. They might still talk or do things together, but they won't share the deepest kind of friendship that comes from God.

When Jesus says there may be division in a family, He means that this happens when not everyone chooses to love and follow God. If someone tries to get you to do something wrong, you must say no. This may upset them, but it is the right thing to do. True unity is only possible in God's truth and love—not in sin.

Think today about what you want most in your heart. Deep down, we all want love. God's love is the most important. When we open our hearts to His love, we can share it with others and receive it from them. Nothing is better than this

## St. Clare of Assisi – August 11th

Next to St. Francis of Assisi, St. Clare (1193-1253) was most responsible for the growth and spread of the Franciscans and the Franciscan ideal. Born in Assisi of wealthy parents, Clare refused to marry in her early teens, as was customary in those days. A few years, later after hearing a sermon by Francis of Assisi, she fled her home to join him and his followers and to live the life of gospel poverty.

Francis received her and gave her the veil at the Portiuncula chapel in Assisi on Palm Sunday in the year 1212. Clare was then nineteen years old. She was shortly joined by her sister, and resisted several attempts by her family to force them to return home. Later, she was joined by another sister and her mother at the convent at the church of San Damiano. Francis charged her under obedience to accept the office of abbess, which she then held the rest of her life – for approximately 40 years.

Clare's understanding of poverty embodied in the Rule of the Poor Clare Nuns today, is rather strict. She was a respected religious person of her time, and was credited with many miracles throughout her life, notably the saving of her convent and the town of Assisi from the Saracen invaders by placing the Blessed Sacrament on the wall of her convent.

St. Clare was exemplary in prayer, patient in suffering, enduring an illness of thirty years that was quite confining yet she was a spirited, energetic leader and spiritual guide. She is portrayed as always loving, kind and charitable toward her sisters, joyful and humble at all times. She was motivated always by her love of the gospel ideal of simplicity of life after the example of Jesus.




