



#### REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL



Jesus said to the Pharisees: "There was a rich man who dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously each day. And lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Dogs even used to come and lick his sores. When the poor man died, he was carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham." Luke 16:19–22

No rational person would want to go to hell. The rich man in this parable certainly did not desire hell, but his actions led him there. Most people, however, do want to be rich in this world. In fact, many people would think it irrational not to desire wealth. It is very rare to find a person who chooses to live in simplicity as a means to deeper spiritual fulfillment and as a preparation for the riches of Heaven. But one clear message from our Gospel story today is that the life that Lazarus lived on earth was far better than that of the rich man. So which life do you prefer here and now? While it is true that the rich man's riches were not the exclusive cause of his eternal damnation, it is also true that his riches imposed upon him a temptation toward selfishness and indifference to the needs of others, which ended in his eternal demise.

One thing that this parable teaches is that material wealth not only adds nothing of value to our eternal reward, it also adds much temptation to our lives. True, if you received a lot of money and then used that money exclusively for good in accord with God's will, that would be a holy act of charity on your part and good for your eternal soul. But doing so would be very difficult. It would be very difficult to resist the temptations that come from material wealth.

Reflect, today, upon the stark contrast between Lazarus and the rich man. One dined sumptuously every day, was clothed in fine linen and purple garments and then spent eternity in the netherworld where he was tormented. The other longed to eat the scraps from another's table, had no home, was covered in sores, but spent eternity in Heaven after being carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham. Choose to imitate Lazarus rather than the rich man. If you have many material possessions, work hard at being detached from them. Live simply, be generous, and never neglect those in need. If you have very little, do not covet more. Eliminate envy, don't despair, trust in the providence of God, and rejoice that, like Lazarus, you are able to build up eternal riches within your soul that will remain with you forever.

## **GROW IN YOUR FAITH**



Nobody really wants to go to hell. The rich man in Jesus' story didn't want that either, but the way he lived led him there. Most people want to be rich. They think it is strange not to want money. But Jesus shows us that Lazarus, the poor man, was better off. He had little on earth, but he found great joy in Heaven. The rich man had many things, but he forgot to care for others, and that hurt his soul.

This story teaches us that money does not help us get to Heaven. In fact, it can make life harder if we only think about ourselves. If we use money to help others, that is good, but it is not easy. Riches can tempt us to be selfish.

Think about Lazarus and the rich man. The rich man wore fine clothes and ate big meals every day, but in the end he suffered. Lazarus was poor and sick, but the angels carried him to Heaven. Jesus wants us to live more like Lazarus—simple, thankful, and trusting in God. If you have much, share it. If you have little, do not be jealous. Trust God and know that the treasures of Heaven last forever.

### St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist September 21st

In the Gospel of Matthew, the name appears in the list of apostles, and is identified at his call as "a man named Matthew, sitting at his custom post."

Later in the list he is called "Matthew the tax collector". In the other synoptic gospels tradition identifies him with Levi. Tradition credits him as the author of the gospel that bears his name, (though some believe that the text we now have is the work of a Jewish Christian from Antioch from around the year 90). Of his later life we know nothing. Tradition says he preached in Judea and later in Ethiopia where he was martyred.

The Gospel of Matthew has a unique point of view, namely to show Jesus as the Messiah foretold in the Old Testament. In his introduction to this gospel in The Jerome Biblical Commentary, John L. McKenzie wrote: "There are points of contact between Matthew and rabbinical writings that are not found in the other Gospels. These points of contact are more than an interest in the Law and allusions to Jewish institutions. Matthew sometimes moves in the world of rabbinical thought. He not only is familiar with rabbinical teaching; he uses it."

Matthew wants to make the point for a Jewish audience that "Jesus Messiah is the new Moses and the new Israel, and the fulfillment of the Law and the Prophets" (ibid). There are 41 references to the Old Testament in Matthew's gospel, and Fr. McKenzie points out that 37 of them are introduced with a formula, most commonly "that it might be fulfilled." (ibid).

Jesus is shown as a teacher who is superior to the rabbis. A long summary of the teaching of Jesus, is given as the Sermon on the Mount, which is kind of a "catechism of Christian conduct." The miracles show Jesus as the messianic wonderworker. The kingdom of heaven (or of God) is presented as a present and future reality, and is identified with eternal life. Matthew's originality is in his explicit identification of the present kingdom with the Church: "I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church." (16:18). Further on in the gospel Jesus instructs in the matter of fraternal correction. "If he refuses to listen to them (three witnesses), tell the church, If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector." (18:17). Many of the parables, too, teach of the church as an existing society.

Today we ask St. Matthew to help us remain faithful in God's service.


