

### REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL

# GRATEFUL

This story of the ten lepers begins very well for all of them. For nine of them, it ends tragically. For one, it ends in an even better and more glorious way than it began.

The lepers represent us all. Their illness was a symbol of all sin and the consequences of sin. When the disease began, the lepers began to experience the effects of their disease. Discolored and thick dry skin, sores, and rashes would set in. Once detected, each leper was removed from the community to stop the spread of the disease and was only free to associate with other lepers. They no longer could gather freely with their loved ones as the lepers entered isolation and shame. Analogously, all sin has similar effects. Sin causes pain within our souls as we discover the growing wounds it causes. Sin affects our relationships and our ability to freely relate to those whom we love.

The initial cure for sin is simple. We cry out, "Jesus, Master! Have pity on me!" But that is only the first step. By curing the lepers, Jesus was showing us that He had power over our sin. He could forgive us and will forgive us when we seek His mercy. But forgiveness will end in tragedy if it does not lead us to faith and to a following of the will of God with zeal and determination. If we take the forgiveness of sins for granted, then we will be in an even more miserable state than before. The nine lepers who failed to return and give thanks to God represent those who do not convert their lives when touched by God's merciful hand.

This story highlights the importance of our response to God when He does touch us. We must glorify God with a loud voice, fall on our knees before Him and express our deepest gratitude. When the one leper does this, Jesus says to him, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you." That mercy from our Lord was a mercy that touched his soul. It imparted the gift of faith and enabled this man to go forth and be healed with eternal graces.

Too often we turn to God in prayer only when we have a problem. Then, once the problem is taken care of, we pay little to no attention to our Lord. God's role in our lives is not to fix our problems so that we can then go about our daily lives as normal. His mercy must evoke ongoing and profound gratitude. Gratitude to God is nothing other than an acknowledgement of the truth. We owe everything to God. Without Him, we are nothing. We are dead in our sins. Just one leper realized this and was blessed with the gift of faith that saved not only his body, but also his soul.


### <u>Upcoming Meetings:</u>

New Group starting -Recovering from Divorce for Catholics



# St. Bruno, Priest - October 6th

Born in Cologne, Germany in 1030 St. Bruno became a priest, and later professor of theology at Rheims. He was head of the school and chancellor of the diocese. He supported Pope Gregory VII in his efforts to reform the clergy, and experienced personal harassment and difficulties because of it. He had for a long time desired a life of solitude and seized the opportunity to retire from public life. He also persuaded some friends to join him in a rather bleak desert area near Grenoble, Spain, the area of Chartreuse. There, they built an oratory and some small hermitages, and this foundation became the Order of Carthusians.

Their ideal was a life of solitary prayer, with some communal prayer daily, and an occasional meal together on feast days. Later, Bruno was called to Rome by Pope Urban II, a former pupil, to give him counsel in governing the Church. Bruno was able to turn down honors and an archbishopric, and prevailed upon the pope to allow him to return to his solitude. There he continued to guide his monks, to pray and to study.

To the monks, he wrote: "Rejoice, my dearest brothers, because you are so blessed and because of the bountiful hand of God's grace upon you. Rejoice because you have escaped the various dangers and shipwrecks of our stormy world. Rejoice because you have reached the quiet and safe anchorage of a secret harbor..."

"Let us rejoice that since you are unacquainted with the knowledge of letters, almighty God will inscribe in your hearts with His finger not only His love but also the knowledge of His holy law." (From his letter, 2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

St. Bruno believed that moments and times of prayerful solitude are spiritually helpful. They can help us remain faithful as we struggle amid daily problems and changes. They strengthen us to face the challenges around us in the Church and in modern society.

# Food Pantry Update

With the new school year in full swing, our food backpack program is already eight weeks in! Each week, nearly **100 backpacks** filled with food are delivered to **five local elementary schools**, ensuring that our youngest neighbors have enough to eat over the weekend.

Each backpack provides ingredients for two family meals plus a snack bag many children keep at school for snack time. We also include quick after-school meals like soup, ramen, and mac-and-cheese cups.

In addition, we recently helped the Lake Brantley High School PTSO stock their food pantry with everything needed to start the school year strong. None of this would be possible without our wonderful team of volunteers who gather every other Tuesday to pack the bags — we are deeply grateful for their time, care, and dedication!



This fall, we also held two large food distributions in August and September with food provided by Second Harvest. Together, we distributed more than 65,000 pounds of food to 675 families — an incredible outpouring of support! Thank you to everyone who volunteered and made these events possible.

Looking ahead, our next food distribution will be held on October 17.



As we enter the holiday season, we will be having a food drive to collect items for our Thanksgiving and Christmas dinner bags. This year, we aim to assemble 350 bags to support our partner schools, Lake Brantley High School, the Seminole County Sheriff's Office (photo with the Sheriff's at one of our food drives), and our St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) families.




