REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL



What a sad prayer the Pharisee offered. In truth, it was not even a prayer to God, for we are told he "spoke this prayer to himself." The tax collector's prayer, however, was the perfect model of true prayer. He "stood off at a distance, would not even raise his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast and prayed, 'O God, be merciful to me, a sinner."

The difference between these two prayers is the difference between pride and humility. The Pharisee's heart was full of pride, and pride blinds us to who we really are. Saint Teresa of Ávila reminds us that the first step toward God is self-knowledge born of humility. Without it, there is no growth in holiness. The Pharisee stood tall, confident in his own goodness, thanking God not for grace received but for his own accomplishments. His fasting and tithing were not wrong, but he failed to see that even his good works depended on God's grace. Because he asked nothing of God, he received nothing.

The tax collector, on the other hand, knew his need for mercy. His bowed head and humble plea revealed a heart aware of its unworthiness before God. That is why his prayer was heard. God's grace is mercy freely given to those who know they cannot earn it. The tax collector's simple words express the essence of prayer—an honest confession of sin and a cry for mercy.

When you pray, how do you pray? What is the posture of your body and heart? Though we can pray standing, sitting, or lying down, there is deep spiritual value in kneeling or bowing before God. Even a brief moment each day of lowering ourselves before Him reminds us that we depend entirely on His goodness.

Begin your prayer as we begin the Mass - by examining your conscience and humbly admitting your sins. Recognize that you are not worthy of His mercy, yet trust that His mercy is greater than your weakness. Such humility opens the door for God to lift you up, for as Jesus said, "Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

Be Humble


One day, Jesus told a story about two men who went to the temple to pray. One man was proud, and the other was humble.



Guided by your Holy Spirit, guard us from discouragement and give us the grace to be messengers of hope, filled with confidence that nothing can separate us from your love.



St. Teresa of Jesus, Virgin and Doctor

Continued from last week... Teresa's letters and writings are spiritual classics, including her autobiography. Other major writings are The Way of Perfection, 1573; and The Interior Castle, 1577. If you want proof that a mystic (one who has a deep communion with God, often face to face) can be practical, read her writings.

For Teresa, action must begin with prayer and be nourished by contemplation in union with the redeeming Christ (mysticism). She taught that mental prayer is the best means of making oneself available and useful to the Church, and to all in the Church.

In one of her shorter treatises, The Book of Life, she wrote: "Whenever we think of Christ we should recall the love that led him to bestow on us so many graces and favors, and also the great love God the Father showed in giving us his Son as a pledge of his love. Love calls for love in return. So let us strive to keep this always before our eyes and to rouse ourselves to love him. For if at some time the Lord should grant us the grace of impressing his love on our hearts, all will become easy for us and we shall accomplish great things quickly and without effort."

Ours is also a time of turmoil, a time for reform, and a time for liberation in many parts of the world. Modern women have in Teresa a challenging example of dedication to personal prayer coupled with service to and reform for others. She is certainly a woman to admire and to imitate.

Toward the end of her life, Teresa exclaimed: "Oh my Lord! How true it is that whoever works for you is paid in troubles! And what a precious price to those who love you if we understand its value."

In 1970 Pope Saint Paul VI declared her a Doctor (teacher) of the Church. It was a recognition of what the Church long knew, that God by his Spirit "raised up St. Teresa of Jesus to show his Church the way to perfection." So we pray that "her inspired teaching might awaken in us a longing for true holiness."




