#### REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL

"When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took his wife into his home."

This past Tuesday, we heard from Matthew's gospel a parable of two brothers. Both were asked to go and work in the field - the first refused, but eventually went to work, while the second agreed to go out but did not follow through. In this final stretch before we reach the Nativity of Jesus, an invitation is put before us to consider the ways in which we respond to what is asked of us.

We hear that Joseph is a righteous man, unwilling to expose Mary to shame. He is a man who knows the law and follows it, but desires to show compassion rather than judgment on Mary. What must Joseph have felt in that moment, knowing that his betrothed was with child and that the child was not his? In a homily from St. John Chrysostom on this passage, he says this: "For neither when he suspected something painful or amiss could he endure to keep the Virgin with him; nor yet, after he was freed from this suspicion, could he bear to cast her out, but he rather keeps her with him, and ministers to the whole Dispensation."

We see in Joseph a model of virtue that we should desire to emulate. When he was hurt over Mary's pregnancy outside of their marriage, he was not vindictive but compassionate. When he learned of the nature of her pregnancy, and God's desire for him to take her into his house, he took decisive action. He embraced her as his wife and became the caregiver of both Mary and her yet unborn son, Jesus. Joseph knew the direction that God was calling him to walk and went - he answered yes both in word and action, unlike the brothers from Jesus' story who gave their yes through word or action, not both.

In this final period of Advent, consider the ways in which God may be calling you to live out this yes. This is a time to recommit to and repair relationships, to share your joy and love with those who are in great need. There are many in our world now who God wants to reach through our actions let us be decisive as Joseph was. Let us not just say yes with our mouths but through the way we live.

Soon the birth of Jesus will be here and we eagerly await his coming. Let us do what we can to ensure that our hearts are open to receiving him in all the ways he desires to make himself present to us. May God bless you!

Joseph didn't just say "yes" with his words. He said "yes" with his actions. He did what God asked, even when it was hard.

During Advent, we get ready for Jesus. God asks us to love others, to forgive, and to help people in need. We can be like Joseph by saying "yes" and then doing good things.

We will be celebrating the birth of Jesus soon. Let us open our hearts to Him. Let us welcome Him with love.



#### St. John of the Cross, Priest, Doctor - December 14th

The spirituality of John of the Cross was centered on the experience of the Cross. Union with God is achieved through a rigorous discipline, abandonment to God and purification of the will and of the senses. He explains his personal spiritual odyssey in his writings, especially in *The Ascent to Mount Carmel*, but more so in *The Dark Night of the Soul*. It is difficult to

summarize the process of attaining union with God, but perhaps it could be put in this way: If one wants to save one's life, one must first lose it in God through a spirit of abandonment and self-denial.

The spirit of John's writings and life are captured in this following excerpt from a spiritual canticle which we read in the days Office of Readings: "Though holy doctors have uncovered many mysteries and wonders, and devout souls have understood them in this earthly condition of ours, yet the greater part still remains to be unfolded by them and even to be understood by them. We must then dig deeply in Christ. He is like a rich mine with many pockets containing treasures: however deep we dig, we will never find their end nor their limit. Indeed, in every pocket new seams of fresh riches are discovered on all sides."

"Would that men might come at least to see that it is quite impossible to reach the thicket of the riches and wisdom of God except by first entering the thicket of much suffering, in such a way that the soul finds there its consolation and desire. The soul that longs for divine wisdom chooses first, and in truth, to enter the thicket of the cross." (Cf. 2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

One of the great mystics of all time, St. John of the Cross was canonized in 1726, and in 1926 Pope Pius XI proclaimed him a Doctor (Teacher) of the Church.


