

### Reflection on the Gospel

In His humility, Jesus—the Incarnate Son of God—endured the human reality of temptation. God’s original plan was for a unified Kingdom of humans and angels, but the misuse of free will led to the fall of both, introducing sin and cosmic struggle into the world.

Theologians like St. Thomas Aquinas and St. Augustine suggest that angels were originally created to assist humanity and govern the physical world. However, the rebellion of a third of the angels transformed them into demons who now use their natural intellect to deceive. Once stewards of order, these fallen spirits now sow chaos, contributing to the world's suffering.

Today’s Gospel highlights the desert confrontation between Jesus and Satan. Tradition identifies Satan as Lucifer, a high-ranking angel whose pride led him to reject God’s authority. This encounter is profoundly significant: it is the only recorded time Jesus permitted Satan to tempt Him directly. By rejecting these allurements, Jesus began the ultimate defeat of evil—a victory completed through His Passion and Resurrection.

As we begin Lent, we must remember that while Satan is a powerful adversary, he is no match for divine grace. We cannot overcome temptation through our own strength; rather, we find victory by uniting ourselves to Christ. Through Him, we receive the grace necessary to resist the enemy and remain faithful to God’s will.



## Prayer

## Fasting

### Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all 18 years of age and older who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Abstinence is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all other Fridays of Lent by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Remember: If your health or your ability to work would be seriously affected, fasting or abstinence does not apply. If in doubt please speak with one of our Priests or Deacons.




"Seasons of Hope" is a unique grief support program for Catholics that focuses on the spiritual side of grieving the death of a loved one.



**In 2026, Annunciation Church is honored to be chosen as one of the stops on the pilgrimage of the Silver Rose which will arrive here on March 4.**





## 7 Founders of the Order of Servites

Between the years 1225 and 1227, seven young men of prominent Florentine families met together out of their desire to live a life of special devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

They came to understand through prayer and spiritual direction as well as a revelation from the Virgin Mary, that they were chosen "to be her servants...and to follow the Rule of St. Augustine." They became known as the Servites or Servants of Mary.

After several years of life in solitude and prayer, at the wish of their bishop six of them were ordained as priests, while Alexis humbly begged to remain a brother. The new community adopted a form of religious life after the Mendicants (begging orders), and their numbers rapidly increased. They began to engage in the active ministries of teaching, preaching in parish-based ministry. All seven cofounders remained very active throughout their lives. Alexis supposedly lived to the age of 110.

The Church is aware that religious orders and congregations have a prophetic role (by words and actions they proclaim the Good News), as should we. This is noted in the Second Vatican Council's documents, speaking in the present, but also in recognition of the past. The Council stated in the Constitution on the Church that "the Church will ensure the establishment of religious institutes to build up the Body of Christ" (Cf. n. 45). In an exhortation in 1971 to religious orders we read also: "The charism of the religious life far from being an impulse born of flesh and blood, or one derived from a mentality which conforms itself to the modern world, is the fruit of the Holy Spirit, who is always at work within the Church." (Evangelica Testificatio n. 11).

Each year on February 17th, with the exception of those dates which fall on Sundays, we honor these seven saints, filled with Love, inspired by God's grace to honor our Holy Mother with special devotion, who had the courage and vision to give themselves to the work of building up the Body of Christ. Their work continues today in the religious community they founded, the Servants of Mary, as they continue to lead people to God.




