

Let's rejoice! During this past weekend, Bishop Noonan celebrated the Rite of Election at not one but three locations (including our Parish) within the diocese, due to a record number of 900+ catechumens. Let us pray for these men and women as they have been officially declared the elect and prepare for their baptism into the Catholic Church.



Reflection on the Gospel

"Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." Matthew 17:4

The Apostle Peter's reaction to the Transfiguration reveals that he was overwhelmed by his firsthand experience of a glimpse of Jesus' true glory. Not long before this moment, our Lord took His disciples north to Caesarea Philippi and asked them privately who they thought He was. Peter boldly proclaimed, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:16). In response, Jesus promised Peter that He would build His Church upon Peter's profession of faith and that Peter himself would be entrusted with the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven. It was a good day for Peter.

In today's Gospel, we hear the story of the Transfiguration. Interestingly, Jesus allowed the disciples to reflect on His prediction of suffering for six days before taking Peter, James, and John up a mountain for prayer and solitude. Jesus, aware of their confusion and struggles, was transfigured before their eyes. "[H]is face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, conversing with him" (Matthew 17:2-3). Peter exclaimed in this moment of glory, "Lord, it is good that we are here." It was another good day for Peter.

We all have good days and bad days. But what defines a good day versus a bad day? Was the day of Jesus' Crucifixion a bad one for Him? Certainly not. Though filled with intense suffering, it was the most glorious day in history because His perfect obedience to the Father's will was fulfilled. Similarly, Peter's good and bad days can be understood in terms of his willingness to obey Christ, especially when the demands were great.

In our lives, we must also define our good and bad days through the lens of obedience to God's will, especially when His will calls us to bear the Cross and practice sacrificial love. It's easy to love God when we are consoled, but it becomes much more difficult when we face trials. Peter's declaration, "Lord, it is good that we are here," is the perfect prayer for us to echo in every circumstance. When we are consoled, as Peter was at the Transfiguration, we must pray this prayer. But unlike Peter's earlier missteps, we must also say, "It is good," when we encounter opportunities for sacrificial love, even when difficult.





Fasting

Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all 18 years of age and older who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Abstinence is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all other Fridays of Lent by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Remember: If your health or your ability to work would be seriously affected, fasting or abstinence does not apply. If in doubt please speak with one of our Priests or Deacons.


Silver Rose Pilgrimage In honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe



The Silver Rose represents the roses gathered from the frozen earth at the top of Tepeyac Hill by Juan Diego at the instruction of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Each year, Silver Roses leave Canada and are stewarded along routes through the United States for their final destination in Mexico.



St. Casimir – March 4

From his early years, the son of the king of Poland, Casimir (1458-1483) was an exceptional student. He was virtuous and devout, and sensed the importance of prayer and practiced austere penances. Those around him described him as "serene and cheerful, and pleasant to all."

When he was 15 years old, his father was prevailed upon to send him to Hungary to be king. But rivalries and wars were so contrary to his character that he returned to Poland, and resolved never to be involved in war. Vowed to celibacy he refused marriage and returned to study and prayer. His ardent devotion to Christ in the Holy Eucharist and to Mary motivated his charity toward the poor. A biographer who was his contemporary wrote:

"Nothing was more pleasant, nothing more desirable for him, than to share his belongings, and even to dedicate his entire self to Christ's poor, to strangers, to the sick, to those in captivity and to all who suffer."

The same biographer also wrote of him: "Daily he urged his father to practice justice throughout his kingdom...He actively took up the cause of the needy and unfortunate...He was never unapproachable...He always preferred to be counted among the meek and poor in spirit, had no ambition for the power that lies in human rank...He was afraid the barbs of wealth...would wound his soul." (Cf. 2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

St. Casimir died at the age of 23, of lung trouble and was canonized in 1521. He is honored especially in Poland and in Lithuania where he is buried in Vilna. Among all people, this youthful saint offers hope as they learn from him that "peace is not won by war: sometimes a comfortable peace is not even won by virtue," but Christ's spirit and peace can overcome all difficulty.


