## Reflection on the Gospel

Imagine being blind your entire life and then suddenly receiving sight. Every sound from childhood, everything touched, tasted, or smelled would take on new form as images registered for the first time. Trees you had only heard rustling in the wind could now be seen glimmering in sunlight. Just as this man was filled with awe, so too is the soul overwhelmed when freed from the blindness of sin and brought into the light of God's grace.

Those who receive sight after a lifetime of blindness are given a gift the sighted never experience. Perceiving the world through four senses alone, and then suddenly gaining the fifth, produces immediate wonder and profound gratitude for something most of us take entirely for granted.

Consider someone who has lived in sin for many years, understanding life only through its distortions. Once freed, their spiritual eyes are opened. Those who experience such a conversion understand the stark contrast between blindness and sight in a way that those who have always walked faithfully may never fully grasp. They will never forget the weight of the bondage they once carried.

God permitted this man to be born blind to illustrate the contrast between spiritual darkness and light — what Jesus means when He says the man was born blind "so that the works of God might be made visible through him." The miracle demonstrated divine power, but pointed to something far deeper: the spiritual healing Christ offers every soul.

We are all born with impaired spiritual sight. Our fallen nature tends toward selfishness and sin. With good formation, we gradually learn the value of patience and selfless love. But those who resist this formation never gain clearer vision, and divine wisdom cannot penetrate a heart that refuses to see.

The man born blind invites each of us to honestly examine how clearly we perceive the world around us. It takes humility to admit we see poorly, and even greater humility to acknowledge we may be blinded by sin. Look to the wonder of this healed man, and trust that our Lord desires nothing more than to give us eyes that truly see.







## St. Frances of Rome – March 9

Frances (1384-1440) lived in Rome and was "a woman of the home and of the world." Married at the age of 13, she was a devoted wife for 40 years and raised three children. Throughout her life, she found time for works of piety and charity. She was joined in this by her sister-in-law, Vannoza. Together they visited the poor and the sick of Rome, often in trying circumstances – during the plague and famine, as well as several invasions of the city by anti-papal factions.

After the death of her husband, Frances entered the religious foundation of the Oblates of Mary, whom she had earlier organized as a group of lay women who lived at home, without taking vows. They were dedicated to helping the poor and the sick, particularly the most difficult cases. Frances' last years were marked by penance, which was sometimes very austere. Many came to her for advice and guidance, as well as for cures. Needless to say, she was loved by all.

We have a testimony of her life that is about three hundred years old, and is taken from a life written by Mary Magdalene Anguillaria, a member of Frances' community:

"God not only tested the patience of Frances with respect to her material wealth...He also tested her own body in a variety of ways, especially through long and serious illnesses which she had to undergo. And yet no one ever observed in her a tendency toward impatience...The gifts he conferred upon her were to be for the spiritual and physical advantage of her neighbor. For this reason he made her so lovable that anyone with whom she spoke would immediately feel captivated by love for her and ready to help her in anything she wanted." (2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

The Collect of our Mass for this Lenten feast of St. Frances of Rome notes that in her, God has "given us a unique example of love in marriage as well as in religious life." Other saints have done this as well – Elizabeth Ann Seton readily comes to mind. But today we ask through the intercession of St. Frances of Rome for the grace to be faithful in God's service, and to see and follow Jesus in all aspects of life.
