

## Reflection on the Gospel



The two disciples were overwhelmed by grief and bewildered by recent events. As they walked the seven miles from Jerusalem to Emmaus, they expressed their sadness and confusion. Jesus, Whom they had hoped "would be the one to redeem Israel," had been brutally crucified. After His burial, they heard reports that His body was missing from the tomb, that the burial cloth was neatly rolled up, and that the women had seen "a vision of angels who announced that he was alive." The two did not know what to think.

As the story unfolds, Jesus appeared and walked with them, "but their eyes were prevented from recognizing him." His hidden presence teaches us that He is often with us, yet we do not recognize Him. Distractions, trials, or our own misconceptions can dull our spiritual senses, causing us to miss His presence in the Eucharist, the Scriptures, prayer, and in one another.

Jesus lovingly rebuked them: "Oh, how foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke!" Every time we stumble from spiritual blindness, our Lord says the same to us. We must receive that rebuke with humility, acknowledging our inability to perceive His constant presence.

Jesus then "interpreted to them what referred to him in all the Scriptures," opening their minds to the Gift of Understanding. We cannot acquire this gift on our own — only by humbly acknowledging our blindness before God will He open our minds to what we need to know.

When they arrived in Emmaus, Jesus agreed to stay with them. At table, "he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them," and suddenly "their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight."

Though He vanished, He remained with them, as He does with us today. By revealing Himself through Scripture and the Breaking of the Bread, He teaches us that He is always present in His Word and the Sacraments — encountered through daily meditation, the teachings of the Church, and our participation in the Mass.

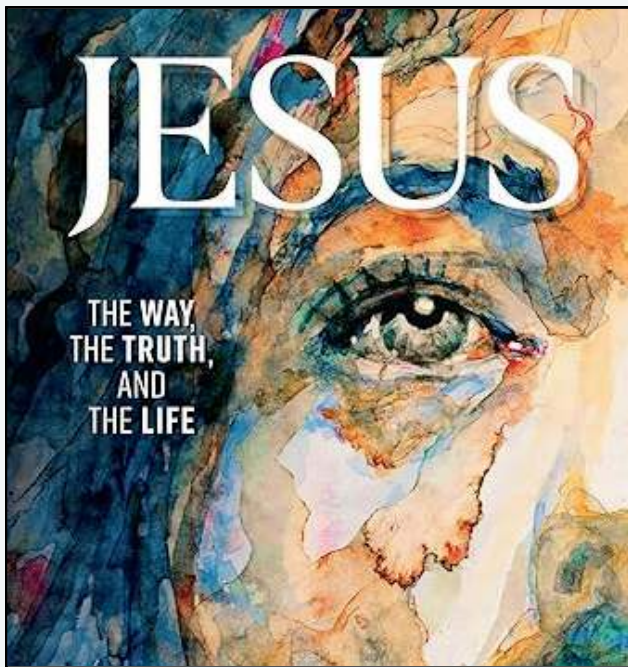

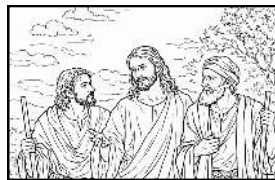

### Jesus is Always With US

Two of Jesus' friends were very sad. They did not understand what had happened. They were walking to a town called Emmaus. It was a long walk. While they walked, they talked about Jesus. He had died on the cross. They missed Him very much. That morning, some friends told them Jesus was not in His tomb anymore. Angels said He was alive! But they did not know what to think.

## Pillars of Faith

### St. Martin I, Pope and Martyr – April 11

Known for his learning and piety, St. Martin I was elected pope in the year 649, a time of difficulty. The Church again had to struggle against a new heresy - monotheletism, which denied that Jesus had both a human and a divine will, thus denying that he had two complete and perfect natures.

Martin was vigorous in condemning this error at the Lateran Synod in 649. Infuriated, the Emperor Constans had Martin taken prisoner and brought to Constantinople. Already ill, he was further mistreated and humiliated, condemned and publicly flogged. He died as a result of all this and more mistreatment in the year 656, the last of the popes to be honored as a martyr.

It was a painful time for St. Martin. From his confinement he wrote of his loneliness and expressed his trust in God. "I am writing to you of things which do oppress us. I have been amazed and continue to be amazed at the lack of perception and the callousness of those who were once connected with me, both my friends and my relatives. They have all completely forgotten about my unhappy state, and do not care to know where I am, whether I am alive or dead."

What had distressed Martin was that the Roman church had abandoned him and even elected a successor in his place, Eugene I, who is described as a mild and saintly man. Martin acquiesced, but Eugene proved to be ineffective, although he was revered for his goodness. He died about two years after St. Martin, and Eugene also is honored as a saint. Martin's trust in God and his acquiescence to Eugene's election is expressed in the same letter: "God wishes all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth through the prayers of Peter. Hence, I pray that God will strengthen all in the orthodox faith, help them to stand firm against every heretic and enemy of the Church, and guard them unshaken. And I ask this especially for their shepherd to Eugene, now designated to be over them, that none may fall or go astray." (Cf. 2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

We honor St. Martin I whose faith could not be weakened by "hardship, pain, nor the threat of death," and we ask for "courage to endure whatever sufferings" may be inflicted upon us. (Cf. Collect of Mass).
