## Special Collection for Venezuela

My Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Grace and Peace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. We are called to assist our brothers and sisters in Venezuela who are faced with the loss of their loved ones, their worldly possessions and economic livelihood due to the recent 7.2 and 7.5-magnitude twin earthquakes. The death toll has risen to over 1,400 people and there are still ongoing efforts to rescue those that are trapped in the rubble. We offer our prayers to all the families affected by these disasters and pray for the repose of the souls whose lives were taken.

In solidarity with our brothers and sisters, I ask you to participate in Disaster Relief 2026, a voluntary special collection for the humanitarian, long-term recovery, and Church needs arising from these calamities. The funds collected in this special appeal will be used to support the efforts of the official relief agencies of the U.S. Catholic Church, Catholic Charities USA and/or Catholic Relief Services, as they and their local agencies respond to immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter, and medical care, and aid in long-term rebuilding and recovery efforts; and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church.

We pray our love of God and neighbor are worthy of His mandate.

## Reflection on the Gospel

In the original Greek, the phrase “I give praise to you...” (exomologoumai) indicates an open, public, and full acknowledgment by the Son of the Father’s sovereignty and gracious will. The Father is the All-Powerful Lord of all that exists—everything in the heavens and on earth. Jesus expresses this fundamental stance toward the Father for two reasons: first, because it is eternally true; and second, so that we might humble ourselves and join Him in praying the same prayer—through, with, and in Jesus.

This prayer closely parallels the opening of the Lord’s Prayer (the “Our Father”), because both begin with a direct acknowledgment and praise of the Father’s holiness and sovereignty. The Lord’s Prayer is the perfect prayer precisely because it was given to us by Jesus Himself. After addressing the Father, it presents seven petitions. According to Saints Thomas Aquinas and Augustine, the first two petitions—“hallowed be Thy name” and “Thy Kingdom come”—reveal the central purpose of our lives: to glorify God eternally and to be caught up in, and actively participate in that glory by becoming full members of His Kingdom. In today’s prayer, Jesus says “these things” have been revealed “to little ones” and that the Son can choose to reveal the Father to whom He wishes.

We are drawn into Jesus’ prayer and intimate relationship with the Father precisely when Jesus reveals the Father to us: “No one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wishes to reveal him.” Because Jesus deeply desires that we come to know and love the Father with the same love He has for Him, His prayer continues by gently inviting us—especially when burdened by weariness, weakness, or sin—to lay our burdens down before His merciful power and glory: “Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest” (Matthew 11:28).

This tender invitation reveals Jesus’ deepest desire for us: that we would enter into His love for the Father, share intimately in the union between Father and Son, and thus magnify and glorify the Most Holy Trinity—not only in our earthly journey but eternally in Heaven. Indeed, what a sublime and glorious calling we have received!

### Traditional Catechesis

Confirmation is celebrated in 9th grade or later. To be prepared for Confirmation in 9th grade, all 8th grade students should be enrolled in a Catholic Faith Formation program or attend a Catholic school. We look forward to celebrating this beautiful Sacrament with your family!

### Sunday School

Sunday School will be offered to active registered parish members during the 10am Mass in the Preschool for ages 2, 3, and 4. Your child(ren) must be the age you wish to register them in by September 1, 2026 to be eligible for Sunday School. ## Pillars of Faith

### St. Cyril of Alexandria, Bishop & Doctor

A very controversial figure at a very controversial time in the history of Catholic doctrine is our saint for this week. St. Cyril was born in 370 and lived a monastic life. He was ordained a priest and succeeded his uncle as Bishop of Alexandria in 412.

He was a very capable, intelligent and forceful bishop at a time of theological crisis. He is remembered primarily today as the defender of the divine motherhood of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Bishop Cyril courageously taught that Mary was the Mother of God. He championed that doctrine at the Council of Ephesus in 431 A.D. He fought bravely against the Nestorians who denied the divine motherhood of Mary, claiming that she was only the mother of the human Jesus.

As Cyril declared at the Council of Ephesus, "That anyone could doubt the right of the holy Virgin to be called the Mother of God fills me with astonishment. Surely, she must be the Mother of God if our Lord Jesus Christ is God, and she gave birth to him!"

He went on to quote a Church Father, Athanasius, who several times referred to Mary as the Mother of God: "As I have often told you, the distinctive mark of Holy Scripture is that it was written to make a twofold declaration concerning our Savior; namely, that he is and has always been God, since he is the Word, Radiance, and Wisdom of the Father; and that for our sake in these latter days he took flesh from the Virgin Mary, Mother of God, and became man."

The theological controversies of the fourth and fifth centuries occasioned a lot of animosity among the disagreeing theologians and bishops. Possibly, some of this could have been avoided with sensitivity on both sides of issues. Certainly, had there been more charity from all the participants and principal characters involved, this would have been the case.

Cyril didn't wear his piety or prayerfulness on his sleeve. He was very adamant, very abrasive, if his contemporaries are believed, domineering but very orthodox. He was an outstanding defender of Catholic truth, and revered today as a Doctor or teacher of the Church.

Despite his human frailties, he remains one of the greatest figures of early Christian literature. Johannes Quasten, the outstanding scholar of patristic times (of the Fathers of the Church), says that his writings reveal "a depth of thought and richness of ideas, a precision and clarity of argument." He was an articulate teacher.

May St. Cyril of Alexandria intercede for us so that we may believe courageously and profess that belief in living witness to Jesus, the incarnate Son of God, born of the Virgin Mary.

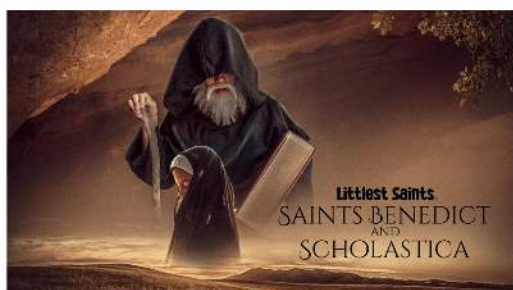

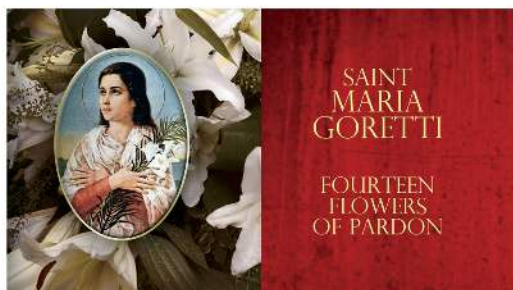
