Reflection on the Gospel

Yeast is small—invisible once it is worked into the dough. And yet, its influence is pervasive and powerful. This simple image—yeast worked into three measures of flour, causing it to slowly rise—reveals that the Kingdom of Heaven is built quietly, almost imperceptibly, from within. Like leaven silently transforming dough from the inside, so too does God's grace operate—hidden yet active—in the heart, in the Church, and in the world.

Patiently watching dough rise can be a small wonder, especially for children. In this brief parable, the yeast symbolizes the Word of God, and the wheat flour, the human soul. When God's Word is welcomed by faith, it possesses the power to transform the entire soul. Just as yeast elevates and expands flour into bread, so God's Word elevates human nature and conforms it to Himself. How awe-inspiring it is to behold the gradual transformation of a soul animated by divine grace!

Saint Augustine offers several interpretations of the "three measures" of wheat flour. He suggests they can represent the threefold interior life of the human person: heart, soul, and mind (cf. Matthew 22:37); or the three degrees of fruitfulness described in the parable of the sower—"a hundredfold, sixtyfold, and thirtyfold" (cf. Matthew 13:23); or even the three righteous men mentioned in Ezekiel—Noah, Daniel, and Job (cf. Ezekiel 14:14), each representing a distinct path of fidelity under trial. Each of these interpretations reveals how God's transforming Word is at work not only in the individual soul, but within the Church and throughout all humanity.

Though "three measures" might not sound like much, it was in fact a substantial amount. According to ancient Jewish and Roman measurements, three measures (or satons) could equal nearly fifty pounds of flour—enough to feed more than a hundred people. The parable, therefore, is about abundance—the superabundant fruitfulness of God's Word when it is thoroughly received—penetrating deeply into the individual soul, the Church, and society. Like leaven in dough, this transformation takes time. Though not immediate, it is steady, enduring, and complete.

Consider your own life: Has the Word of God been thoroughly mixed into your whole being—into your heart, your soul, and your mind? Has it leavened your interior life so completely that even your smallest actions are touched by grace? Has divine love taken hold of you—not in part, but in whole?

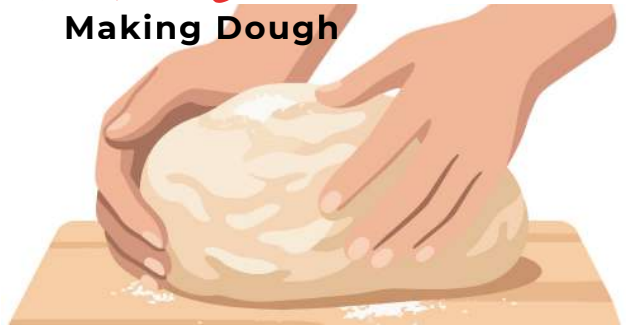
Catechesis Corner

What Is Catechesis?

The word catechesis means "instruction by word of mouth" or "to echo." In the Church, catechesis is much more than memorizing facts about our faith. It is the lifelong process of learning about Jesus Christ, growing in friendship with Him, and allowing His teachings to shape the way we worship, pray, and live. The Catechism describes catechesis as the Church's efforts "to make disciples," to help people believe in Jesus, and to educate them in the Christian life.

Through this weekly Catechesis Corner, we will explore the teachings of our Catholic faith and discover how they lead us into a deeper relationship with Christ and His Church. (See Catechism of the Catholic Church - CCC 4-5.)

The Kids Bulletin Making Dough



Jesus said that God's Kingdom is like yeast mixed into flour. Yeast is very small. Once it is mixed into the dough, we cannot see it. But the yeast is still working. Little by little, it helps the dough grow and rise.

God's love works in us in a similar way. We may not always see what God is doing, but He is always close to us. He works quietly in our hearts. He helps us learn to love, forgive, share, and care for others.

When we listen to God's Word, it begins to change us. At first, the change may seem small. We may say one kind word, help someone, or remember to pray. But each small act helps God's love grow in us.

Just as yeast changes all the dough, God wants His love to fill our whole life. He wants to be part of our thoughts, our words, and our actions. He wants us to bring His love to our families, our friends, and everyone we meet.

It takes time for dough to rise. It also takes time for us to grow closer to God. We do not have to become perfect all at once. We only need to trust God and let Him work in us each day.

Even when the world seems sad or scary, God is still working. His Kingdom is growing quietly in every loving word, every prayer, and every good deed. God can use even the smallest act of love to do something wonderful.

Traditional Catechesis

Annunciation Traditional Catechesis is offered for grades 1-5 each Wednesday at 4:15pm or grades 1-8 at 6:15pm. Each session is 1 hour and 15 minutes. In-person sessions begin August 26th.



Family Catechesis

Annunciation Family Catechesis uses the Finding God curriculum to combine parish-based group meetings (parent/guardian & child) and grade-specific instruction by trained catechists with at-home sessions guided by parents. The first in-person session is September 14th.

Confirmation

Confirmation is celebrated in 9th grade or later. To be prepared for Confirmation in 9th grade, all 8th grade students should be enrolled in a Catholic Faith Formation program or attend a Catholic school. We look forward to celebrating this beautiful Sacrament with your family!

Confirmation Preparation

Requirement: Students planning to receive Confirmation in 9th grade must either attend a Catholic school or be enrolled in a parish Faith Formation program during 8th grade. Students should not register for Confirmation while in 8th grade; Confirmation enrollment takes place in 9th grade.

Sunday School

Sunday School will be offered to active registered parish members during the 10am Mass in the Preschool for ages 2, 3, and 4. Your child(ren) must be the age you wish to register them by September 1, 2026 to be eligible for Sunday School. There is limited space so please only register your child if you plan to attend weekly. The first in-person session will be September 13th.

Pillars of Faith

St. Elizabeth of Portugal

Married at age 12, to King Denis of Portugal, St. Elizabeth of Portugal (1271-1336), was a mother of two children, she was a pious, and a very gracious and charitable lady. She showed great concern for the poor, abandoned children and wayward girls. Her charity in these concerns was outstanding.

Elizabeth's marriage was a difficult one, as her husband was flagrantly unfaithful, jealous and quarrelsome. Throughout her life, as queen, and later as a widow and a third order Franciscan, she promoted peace among quarrelling factions in her own family. The opening prayer of the Mass notes this – that she "had a marvelous grace for reconciling those in conflict." Most notably, she brought about a reconciliation between her husband and son.

Elizabeth was a model wife and mother, and she is a model and example for women who find themselves in difficult marriages today. She has been called "peacemaker." In a sermon attributed to St. Peter Chrysologus which we read today, we are told that Christian virtues grow in one "who enjoys the unchangeable possession of Christian peace." The sermon continues: "Peace among brothers and sisters is the will of God...Peace lends strength to our prayer...Peace is the mother of love, the bond of concord and the manifest sign of a pure soul." The life and example of St. Elizabeth of Portugal bears out the truth of these words.

Elizabeth heeded the advice of St. Peter Chrysologus: "We must keep peace before all other virtues, since God is always at peace. Love peace, and all the world will be tranquil and quiet." (2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

We ask in prayer: "Oh God, author of peace and lover of charity... grant through her intercession, that we may become peacemakers, and so be called children of God."

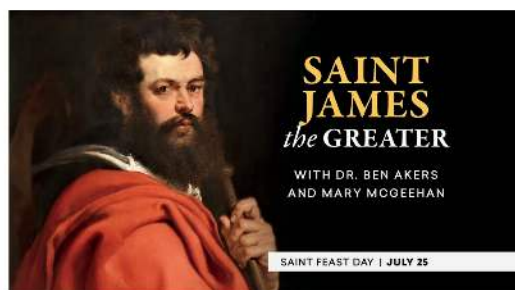

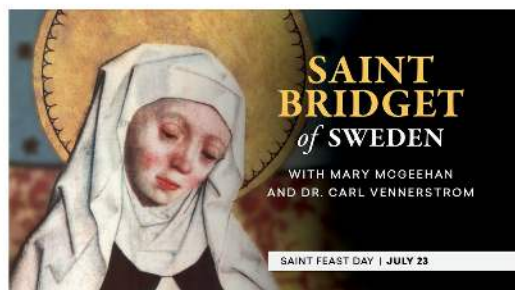

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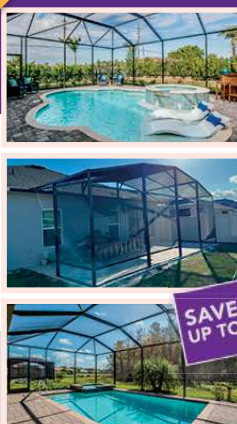
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
