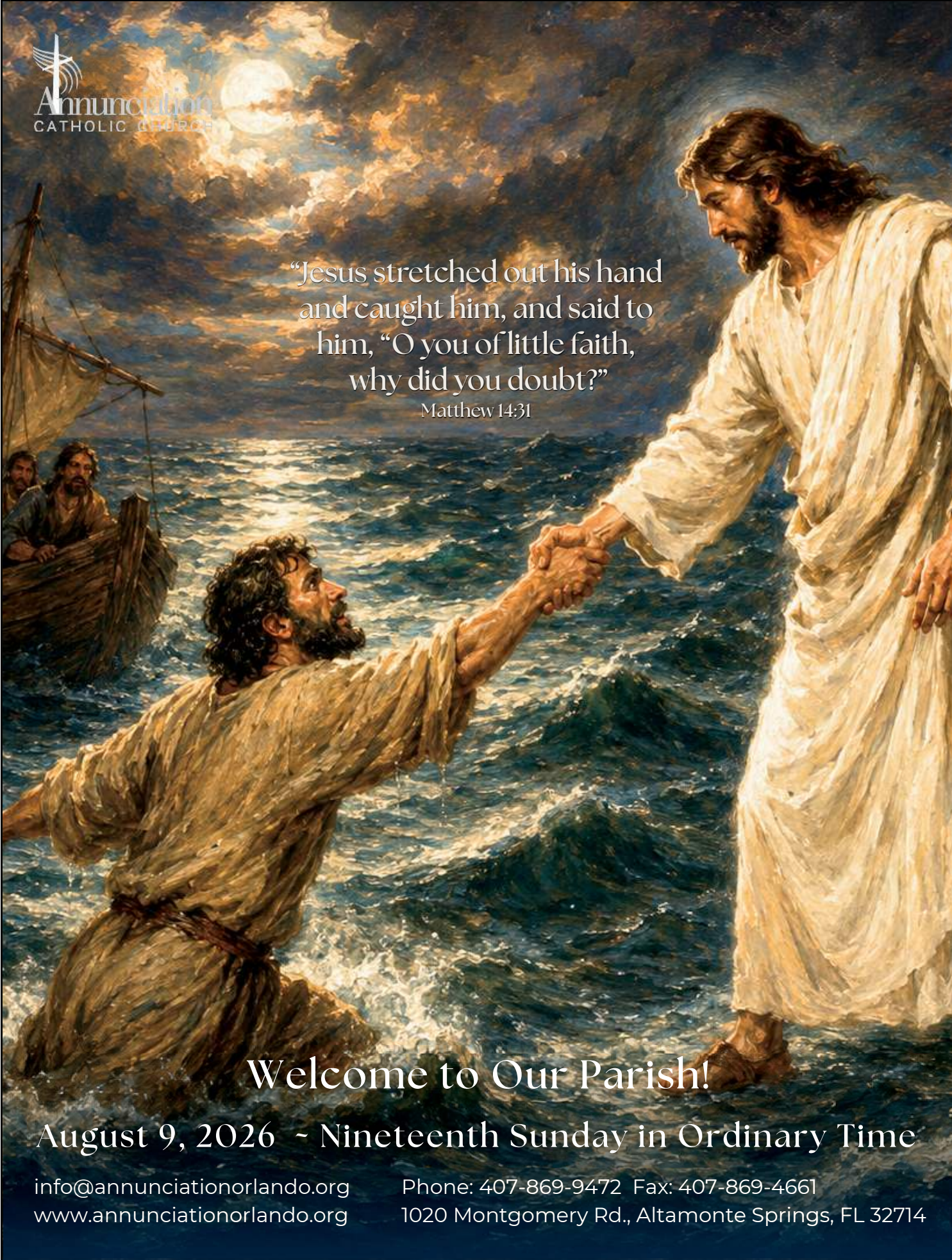

Reflection on the Gospel

In today's Gospel, the disciples found themselves rowing against a strong headwind, making the journey slow, arduous, and perilous. This scene is a vivid image of our journey through life. Life is rarely "a bowl of cherries," as the saying goes. It can often feel laborious, filled with hardships, and some trials may seem never-ending. If life feels this way, today's Gospel is especially for you.

During the fourth watch of the night, between 3 and 6 a.m., as the disciples continued struggling against the waves, they saw a figure walking on the sea, coming toward them. While we may be familiar with the idea of Jesus walking on water, for the disciples, this would have been an unimaginable and terrifying sight. They did not recognize Him—not because His appearance had changed, but because fear blinded them. This still happens in our lives. We can misinterpret suffering or divine silence as abandonment. But Jesus allowed their fear precisely so He could confront it directly: "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." In His divine wisdom, Jesus knew that countless disciples would read this story and ponder this moment until the end of time.

What message is He giving us? The courage that comes from recognizing God in our midst allows us to conquer fear—especially in our moments of suffering, when the path ahead seems hard, dangerous, and without end.

By a supernatural instinct, Peter utters the perfect prayer in this moment of uncertainty: "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you..." When we recognize God amid our trials, focus our gaze on Him, and pray this prayer, God will always answer, "Come."

Peter sets the pattern for this bold, trusting prayer, but he falters in remaining faithful to it. Yet even this is allowed by God, for our instruction. Making an act of courageous faith does not guarantee we will not stumble. Peter sank not because he lacked faith entirely, but because fear began to overwhelm his trust. And in this, Jesus teaches us another lesson: Even when our faith wavers, we must not give in to despair. Peter did not drown—he cried out once more, "Lord, save me!" and Jesus immediately reached out His hand.

Despair is the true enemy of faith. Though fear and the growing force of the wind weakened Peter's faith, he remained hopeful even in his weakness. And it was this hope—however trembling—that moved Jesus to stretch out His divine hand and save him.

Catechesis Corner

What Is Prayer?

Prayer is our living relationship with God. It is more than simply asking God for help; it is spending time with Him, listening to Him, thanking Him, praising Him, and placing our needs before Him. Prayer can take the form of the Church's traditional prayers, such as the Chaplet of Divine Mercy or the Holy Rosary, but it can also be as simple as one friend speaking honestly from the heart to another. Jesus teaches us how to pray through His own example and through the words of the Our Father. Whether we pray silently, with Scripture, at Mass, or with our families, prayer opens our hearts to God's grace and helps us grow in friendship with Him.

Jesus is Near



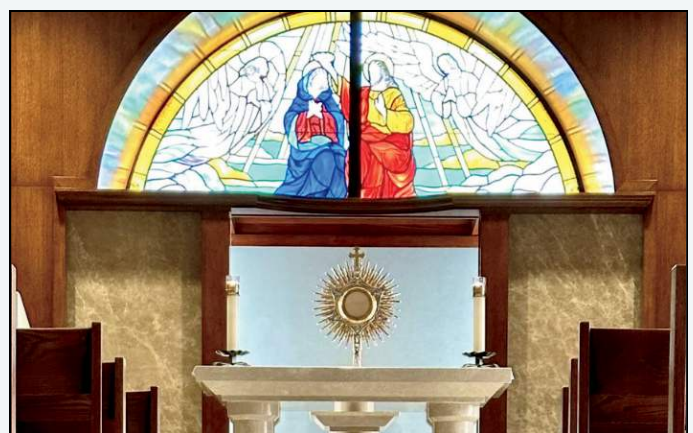
Sometimes we feel afraid. We may worry about what will happen next. We may feel like we are all alone.

Pillars of Faith

St. John Mary Vianney, Priest

In the winter, he spent ten to twelve hours daily in the confessional. In summer, it was as many as sixteen hours. This tells of the dedication of the holy priest we honor today, St. John Vianney (1786-1839). God made him outstanding in his priestly zeal and concern for his people.

St. John was born in 1786 at Lyons, France. He had much difficulty in his studies for the priesthood, however, due to the intercession of a priest, it was determined that "his goodness was sufficient to offset his deficiencies in learning." He then was ordained a priest in 1815. St. John Vianney was appointed "cure" or pastor of Ars (1817), where he remained until his death in 1839.

John set himself the task of waging war on religious indifference, immorality and frivolity, and eventually he reformed the entire village of Ars. Word of his goodness and his gift of insight into the minds and souls of people (a gift from God, also given to St. Padre Pio), led to many seeking him for confession and spiritual direction. His life belonged to these people who entrusted their souls to him. He had little time for a private life though he longed often for a life of solitude. He left the village of Ars several times, but always came back. Constantly, throughout his priestly life, he struggled with the devil. That suffering was added to the cross of disparagement by his superiors and his questioning of his own ability.

Though he was engaged actively in the confessional, the greater part of every day, John had an appreciation for prayer, and he expresses it in his Catechism of Prayer. There we read: "This is the glorious duty of man: to pray and to love. If you pray and love, that is where our happiness lies. Prayer is nothing else but union with God. This union of God with a tiny creature is a lovely thing. It is happiness beyond understanding. Through prayer we receive a foretaste of heaven and something of paradise comes down upon us." (2nd Reading in Liturgy of the Hours).

Liturgical prayer (the Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours) he saw as especially efficacious. "Private prayer is like straw scattered here and there; if you set it on fire it makes a lot of little flames. But gather these straws into a bundle and light them, and you get a mighty fire, rising like a column into the sky. Public prayer is like that."

The alternate gospel reading for today, to be used for parishes named for him (Matthew 9:35- 10:1) is most appropriate and applicable to St. John Vianney, model priest and pastor, faithful follower of the Good Shepherd. What was said of Jesus may also be said of John: "He proclaimed the good news of God's reign, and he cured every sickness and disease. At the sight of the crowd his heart was moved to pity."

The rectory at Annunciation parish was named by now Bishop Stephen Parkes as "the St. John Vianney house" in honor of that saintly patron of priests. In the living room there is a large statue of St. John Vianney and a first class relic, there is also a first class relic of St. Therese of Lisieux, placed inside our church's main altar. We trust that both saints are watching over our parish, and over all of us as Apostles.
