Our Mission Co-op this year was presented by Fr. Ebin Mathew. He is a priest of the Order of Carmelites. Thank you for supporting their mission, raising \$15,954! Fr. Ebin wrote us this past week with an update. Here is an excerpt:

I wanted to share a quick update from my side. Since my return, I have been completely busy with formation work, and I am also serving as a manager at a College here. So life has been quite packed. At the same time, our Finance Commission members and I have been engaging in some charitable works:

1. Support for students: After my arrival and after receiving the Mission Appeal money, it was the start of the new academic year. We identified some very poor students and helped them by buying study materials and also provided financial assistance.

2. Care for the sick: Our Novitiate community found some sick people who need to go through kidney dialysis, cancer treatment, and other serious illnesses. We were able to help them.

3. Help for Joel: We also helped a 7th grade boy named Joel who suffers from Type 1 Diabetes. It is a chronic autoimmune condition where the body's immune system attacks and destroys insulin-producing cells in the pancreas. He needed ongoing support.

4. Local distribution: We have also handed some funds to each community prior to identify people in and around their communities who are most in need, so they can distribute it to deserving people. I am enclosing a few pictures with this email.

Reflection on the Gospel

The scene from the Gospel likely unfolds in or near Caesarea Philippi, a Gentile region steeped in pagan worship. There, at the mouth of a cave long associated with the entrance to the netherworld—believed by some pagans to be the very gate of Hades—Jesus had just questioned His disciples: “Who do people say that the Son of Man is?” and then more directly, “But who do you say that I am?” (cf. Matthew 16:13–15). Peter, speaking with conviction on behalf of the Twelve, boldly proclaimed, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God” (Matthew 16:16). Jesus responded by declaring him “Peter,” the rock upon which He would build His Church, promising that “the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.”

Just moments later, Jesus issues one of the strongest rebukes recorded in the Gospels: “Get behind me, Satan!” The same Peter who had just spoken divine truth now speaks human fear and shortsightedness. In trying to dissuade Jesus from His suffering and death, Peter unknowingly opposes the very mission of the Messiah. Jesus calls this mindset not merely a mistake, but a diabolical temptation—echoing the same temptation He faced in the desert, when Satan sought to lure Him away from the Cross with promises of worldly glory.

What a stark contrast. Peter goes from being the rock of faith to an obstacle in the Lord’s path. But why was Jesus so severe in His response?

Because the stakes were eternal. The Cross is not optional. It is the means of salvation—not just for Jesus, but for all who would follow Him. To think otherwise, even with good intention, is to prefer human comfort over divine wisdom. Peter’s protest reflects a natural aversion to suffering, but Jesus exposes it for what it truly is: a stumbling block to the will of the Father.

This dramatic Gospel scene is recorded for a reason. By calling Peter “Satan,” Jesus wanted to warn him—and us—of the real and ever-present danger of rejecting the way of the Cross. Like Peter, we can easily fall into the trap of wishful thinking and misguided compassion by saying about ourselves or those close to us, “God forbid, Lord! No such thing shall ever happen...” We are saying, in essence: “Lord, please make sure that neither I nor anyone I love ever has to suffer!” But such a prayer, though well-meaning, is clearly mistaken, and Jesus wants that point to be clearly understood.

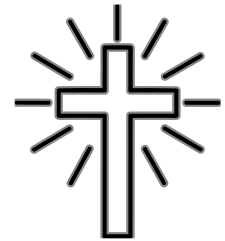

But Jesus knew something Peter did not yet understand. God can bring something good even from something very hard. Jesus would suffer and die on the Cross, but through the Cross, He would save us and open the way to Heaven.

Sometimes we want God to take away every hard thing in our lives. It is okay to ask God for help. But we can also ask Him to help us trust Him when life is hard.

Peter had to learn this. We do too. When something is hard, we can pray, "Jesus, I trust You. Help me follow You."

Sacred Story

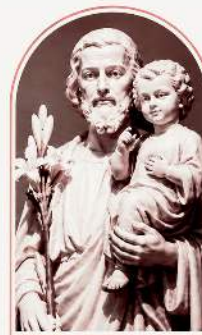

Explain "Ordinary" Time

The word *ordinary* can make this season sound unimportant, but Ordinary Time is anything but ordinary. The name comes from the numbered, or ordered, weeks of the liturgical year. During Ordinary Time, we journey with Jesus through His public ministry, listening to His teaching, witnessing His miracles, and learning what it means to follow Him as disciples. The Church uses green during this season, a color that reminds us of life, hope, and growth. Ordinary Time teaches us that holiness is not only found in great celebrations or special seasons. Most of our lives are lived in ordinary days - and those are exactly the days when Christ calls us to grow closer to Him through prayer, love, service, and faithful discipleship.

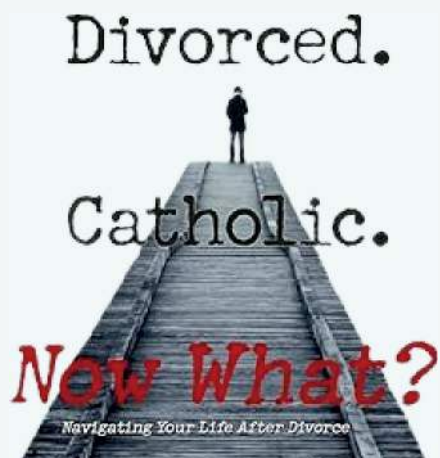

Pillars of Faith

St. Louis

Born in the year 1214, Louis became King of France twenty years later. The greatest influence in his life was his mother, Blanche, who was his regent for eight years after the death of his father. When he reached the age of 20 he was able to assume the throne, and Blanche continued to be his advisor.

Louis' wars and political astuteness are well treated in history books, and are not our concern here. We do associate him with crusades, and he was once captured and ransomed. Louis is better remembered however, for his personal piety, his justice and charity, and especially for his lifelong generosity to the poor of his realm. We may note, too, that his nation prospered throughout his forty-four year reign.

Louis and his wife, Margaret, were the parents of eleven children, all raised and well instructed in the Faith. They were imbued with the principles of the Christian life, mainly by the example of Louis and Margaret, and Louis' mother, Blanche.

In a spiritual testament to his son, we find instruction for all of us: "My first instruction is that you should love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your strength. Without this, there is no salvation...Keep yourself from everything that displeases God...If the Lord has permitted you to have some trial, bear it willingly and with gratitude, considering that it has happened for your good. Be kindhearted to the poor, the unfortunate and the afflicted. Give them as much help and consolation as you can. Be just to your subjects. Be devout and obedient to our mother, the Church. Work to remove all sin from your land." (2nd Reading, Liturgy of the Hours).

While reading the instruction we know that St. Louis is teaching from his own life experience.

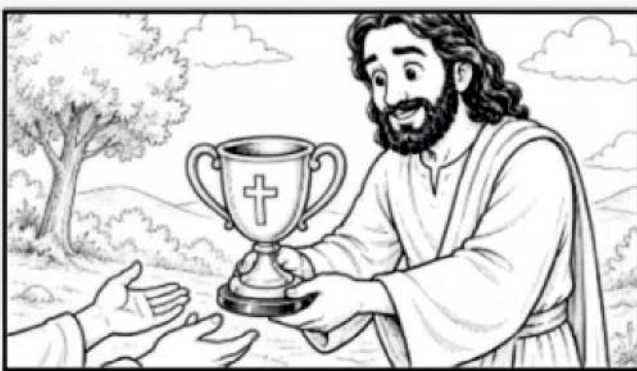
