In 2021, Pope Francis established the celebration of the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. In the U.S., we observe this celebration in September, joining the Church's efforts to highlight the value and importance of grandparents and the elderly in our families and in society.

While the elderly have traditionally held places of honor in various cultures, today, elderly members of our families and communities often live lives marked by isolation and loneliness. Rather than being a beloved and integral part of a family, they are too often forgotten or overlooked. In the most tragic circumstances, some even seek to end their own lives through assisted suicide so as not to be a burden to their loved ones. Pope Francis has described this shift as a "throwaway culture" in which the weakest are neglected or worse when they are no longer of interest or "use."

As persons made in the image and likeness of God, we possess an infinite dignity that can never be compromised by age or ability. This truth must guide each of us in our responsibility to lovingly accompany those who are in greater need of our time, care, and attention as they face their later years. Such accompaniment is of particular importance as they near the end of their lives, often enduring great sufferings as they prepare for their entrance to eternal life. May each of us joyfully proclaim the Lord's promise to each of us: "I will never forget you" (Isaiah 49:15).

Reflection on the Gospel

When someone sins against us, especially in a grievous way, anger and condemnation can quickly arise as strong temptations. Our natural sense of justice often takes over, and we may find ourselves rationalizing a response rooted in judgment rather than compassion. In today's Gospel, however, Jesus offers the much better path—to seek reconciliation, not division. The ultimate goal is to win the sinner back to God and restore the bond of communion.

In today's Gospel, while Jesus appears to be addressing serious sin that severs a person from sanctifying grace - mortal sin - the same principles apply to all offenses, even venial sins and spiritual imperfections. The Christian response to sin must always be grounded in mercy. Whether we are correcting or being corrected, the goal must always be to heal, to restore, and to deepen our unity in Christ.

To begin applying these spiritual principles, call to mind those toward whom you may harbor resentment. Start with your family, since familial bonds - due to their natural closeness - are especially vulnerable to sin. Resentment born of sin is often present in close relationships. While some wounds may have caused deep fractures, even the most loving bonds can suffer subtle injuries. Prayerfully examine these relationships in your life.

If the wounds are deep and hostilities strong, the path forward is usually clear: Seek to win over your brother, sister, parent, or spouse. And if you are the one who has caused the wound, then humbly acknowledge your sin without excuses. That is always the better path. Always.

To aid this process, it is helpful to recognize a hidden dynamic: Holding onto resentment or anger can bring a certain emotional satisfaction. Though it may seem surprising, this is often the case. Anger energizes the emotions and creates a charged feeling that, while disordered, can feel gratifying - like a drug that fuels addiction.

The first step is to recognize this disordered emotional pattern for what it is. The next step is to realize that a healed and reconciled relationship offers a deeper and more lasting fulfillment that is far superior to the fleeting satisfaction of resentment or hostility. Winning over another—or being won over by one we have wronged—is profoundly rewarding. It transcends emotion and enters the realm of grace, producing true peace and spiritual joy. *Source: mycatholic.life*

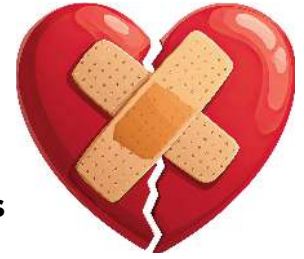

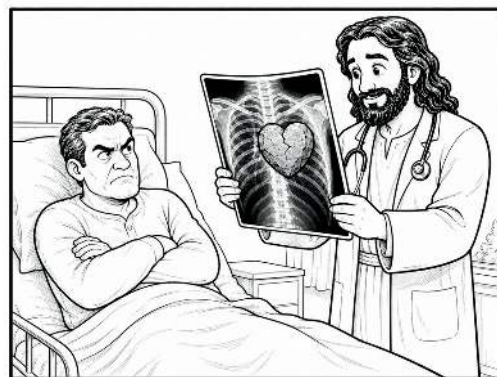

Catechesis Corner

Explain the word "Liturgy"

Liturgy is a word Catholics hear often, but it means much more than simply "going to Mass." The word originally meant a public work or service, and in the Church it refers to our participation in the worship of God and in the saving work of Christ. The Mass is the Church's greatest liturgical celebration, but the liturgy also includes the other Sacraments and the Liturgy of the Hours. Through the liturgy, we do not simply remember what God has done—we enter into the prayer and worship of Christ and His Church. This is why the Second Vatican Council called the liturgy the "summit toward which the activity of the Church is directed" and the "font from which all her power flows." Liturgy is not something we merely watch; it is something the whole Church is called to enter into and participate in.

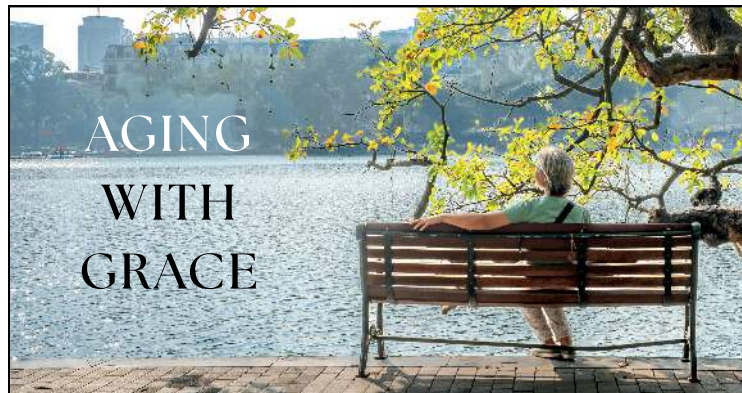

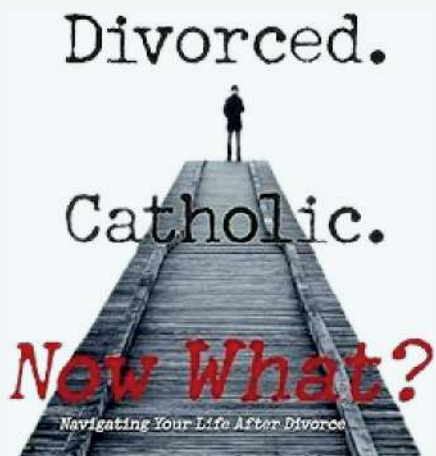

Pillars of Faith

St. Monica

St. Monica (331-387) was born in Tagaste (Numidia) in Africa of Christian parents. Married at an early age to a pagan, Patricius, she had three children, the oldest of whom was Augustine.

Monica's life was a difficult one. She patiently suffered through the dissolute life of her husband and the abuse from her mother-in-law. Her piety and patient charity won the conversion of Patricius a year before his death, and the conversion of his mother as well.

Disturbed by Augustine's rejection of Christianity, she intensified her piety and penance, guided by the wise and gentle Bishop Ambrose of Milan. She lived to see Augustine return to Catholicism and be baptized.

St. Monica is honored as a model for virtuous Christian mothers, and as one who nourished her faith by her prayers and witnessed to it by her deeds. (The Liturgy of the Hours). "While in this world, Monica lived in Christ; the goodness of her life was so evident that the name of the Lord was praised in her faith and in her works." (Antiphon at Magnificat).

St. Monica died in 387, the year of Augustine's Baptism.

"You answered her prayers, O Lord, you did not disregard her tears which fell upon the earth wherever she prayed." (Antiphon at Benedictus).
